I would like to share a devotion again from Oswald Chambers:

## THE GRACIOUSNESS OF UNCERTAINTY

"It doth not yet appear what we shall be." 1 John iii. 2.

Naturally, we are inclined to be so mathematical and calculating that we look upon uncertainty as a bad thing. We imagine that we have to reach some end, but that is not the nature of spiritual life. The nature of spiritual life is that we are certain in our uncertainty, consequently we do not make our nests anywhere. Common sense says— "Well, supposing I were in that condition...." We cannot suppose ourselves in any condition we have never been in.

Certainty is the mark of the common-sense life; gracious uncertainty is the mark of the spiritual life. To be certain of God means that we are uncertain in all our ways, we do not know what a day may bring forth. This is generally said with a sigh of sadness, it should be rather an expression of breathless expectation. We are uncertain of the next step, but we are certain of God. Immediately we abandon to God, and do the duty that lies nearest, He packs our life with surprises all the time. When we become advocates of a creed, something dies; we do not believe God, we only believe our belief about Him. Jesus said, "Except ye ... become as little children." Spiritual life is the life of a child. We are not uncertain of God, but uncertain of what He is going to do next. If we are only certain in our beliefs, we get dignified and severe and have the ban of

finality about our views; but when we are rightly related to God, life is full of spontaneous, joyful uncertainty and expectancy.

"Believe also in Me," said Jesus, not— "Believe certain things about Me." Leave the whole thing to Him, it is gloriously uncertain how He will come in, but He will come. Remain loyal to Him.





### Synod Disaster Response Update: Mid-Michigan Flooding



After 2.5 days of rain on May 17-19, rivers and reservoirs in Gladwin County overflowed and caused two problematic dams downstream to fail. This sent 21.5 billion gallons of water into Sanford, Midland, and parts of Western Saginaw County. Flooding was also recorded in Arenac and Isoco Counties. All five counties have been declared disaster areas by Governor Gretchen Whitmer. The Red Cross is managing the sheltering of people in both counties. Emergency Management Directors are coordinating rescue, sheltering, and beginning to work on recovery.

The North/West Lower Michigan Synod has six congregations in the affected area: Trinity and St. Timothy in Midland, Hope in Rhodes, Christ the King in Gladwin, and St. Paul in Au Gres, and Grace in East Tawas. None of the church buildings are damaged. Trinity, St. Timothy, and Christ the King have members with the most damage to their properties. The North/West Lower Michigan Synod is continuing to partner with Lutheran Disaster Response to provide assistance with immediate needs as well as long term recovery efforts.

We invite you to help by donating to <u>the North/West Lower Michigan Synod Disaster</u> <u>Relief Fund.</u> All funds will be used for direct support of affected residents.

# FRAUD ALERT

The Synod has received reports of people receiving fraudulent emails from Bishop Satterlee asking for money or gift cards. These emails are **not** from Bishop Satterlee. Please **do not** respond to them or send any money or gift cards.

This type of email scam has become prevalent in church communities. In this scam, people pretending to be someone you know send an email asking for help and for you to send them gift cards or wire them money.

If you receive one of these emails, **do not** send any personal information, money, or gift cards. If you are unsure if the email is fraudulent, check the email address it was sent from and contact the person separately (ex: call/text using a number you know is theirs, send a separate email to an account you know is theirs). **Do not** respond to the email you suspect is fraudulent.

If you have had your email account hacked or are worried that it might have been hacked, change your email password. When selecting a new password, make sure to use one that is strong and includes numbers, special characters, and a mix of upper- and lower-case letters.

# Coronavirus Update

On June 1, Governor Whitmer <u>lifted the "Stay Home, Stay Safe" Order and moved</u> <u>the entire state of Michigan into Phase 4 of the MI Safe Start Plan</u>. As part of this plan, outside gatherings of 100 people or less are allowed as long as all participants are wearing masks and practicing social distancing. Indoor gatherings of 10 people or more are still prohibited. In order to give congregations time to plan and prepare, Bishop Satterlee is maintaining his recommendation that congregations suspend all in-person worship services through June 21.

## German Worship Service – June 14th

On Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, St. Lorenz's monthly German worship service will be held at 11:00 am in the Church - 1030 W. Tuscola Rd., Frankenmuth. Safe distance seating, hand sanitizing and face masks (for entering and exiting the building) will be requested to assure we worship safely. The Service focus is on God's provision for His people in all the events and circumstances of our faith journey. Most recently, the pandemic has forcibly caused untold and unanticipated change and challenge in our faith journey. The Old Testament lesson reminds us that He "bears us up on eagles' wings." The English sermon theme is "Wings of His Mercy" and is based on Ex. 19:4 by Pastor Bill Hoesman. The congregation will join in singing favorite hymns including; " O Heilige Dreifaltigkeit" (O Blessed Holy Trinity), "Jesus Jesus nichts als Jesus" (Jesus Jesus Only Jesus), " Lobe den Herren, den mächtigen" (Praise to the Lord, the Almighty), and "Heut fangen wir in Gottes Nam" (As We Begin Another Week).
