#### Food for the Poor

The information that follows gives some background and scope to their ministry to the poor in the Caribbean and Latin America.


## Direct relief assistance helping the poor in the Caribbean and Latin America

Food For The Poor is the largest international relief and development organization in the United States, according to the Chronicle of Philanthropy. Founded in 1982, our interdenominational Christian ministry serves the poorest of the poor in 17 countries throughout the Caribbean and Latin America. Thanks to our faithful donors, our programs provide housing, healthcare, education, fresh water, emergency relief and micro-enterprise assistance in addition to feeding hundreds of thousands of people each day.

Since our inception in 1982, we have provided approximately \$9 billion in aid and have built more than 77,417 housing units for the destitute. In 2011, we constructed 6,294 housing units for families in need of adequate shelter. Total fundraising and administrative costs in 2011 comprised less than 4% of our expenses. More than 96% of all donations go directly to programs that help the poor.

Our hope is that this ministry reflects God's unconditional love, which surrenders all, inspires trust and faith, and embraces all people regardless of race, status or creed. We believe that Christ is alive, and that we can best serve Him by being of assistance to those in the greatest need (Matthew 25:31-40). Finally, we stress the need for regular prayer to guide and maintain the purity of our mission, to link the church of the First World with the church of the Third World in a manner that helps both the materially poor and the poor in spirit.

#### Living The Great Commission




