Students and chaperones enjoyed great speakers, great music, an inspiring Eucharistic Procession, and the closing Mass with Bishop Frank J. Dewane.



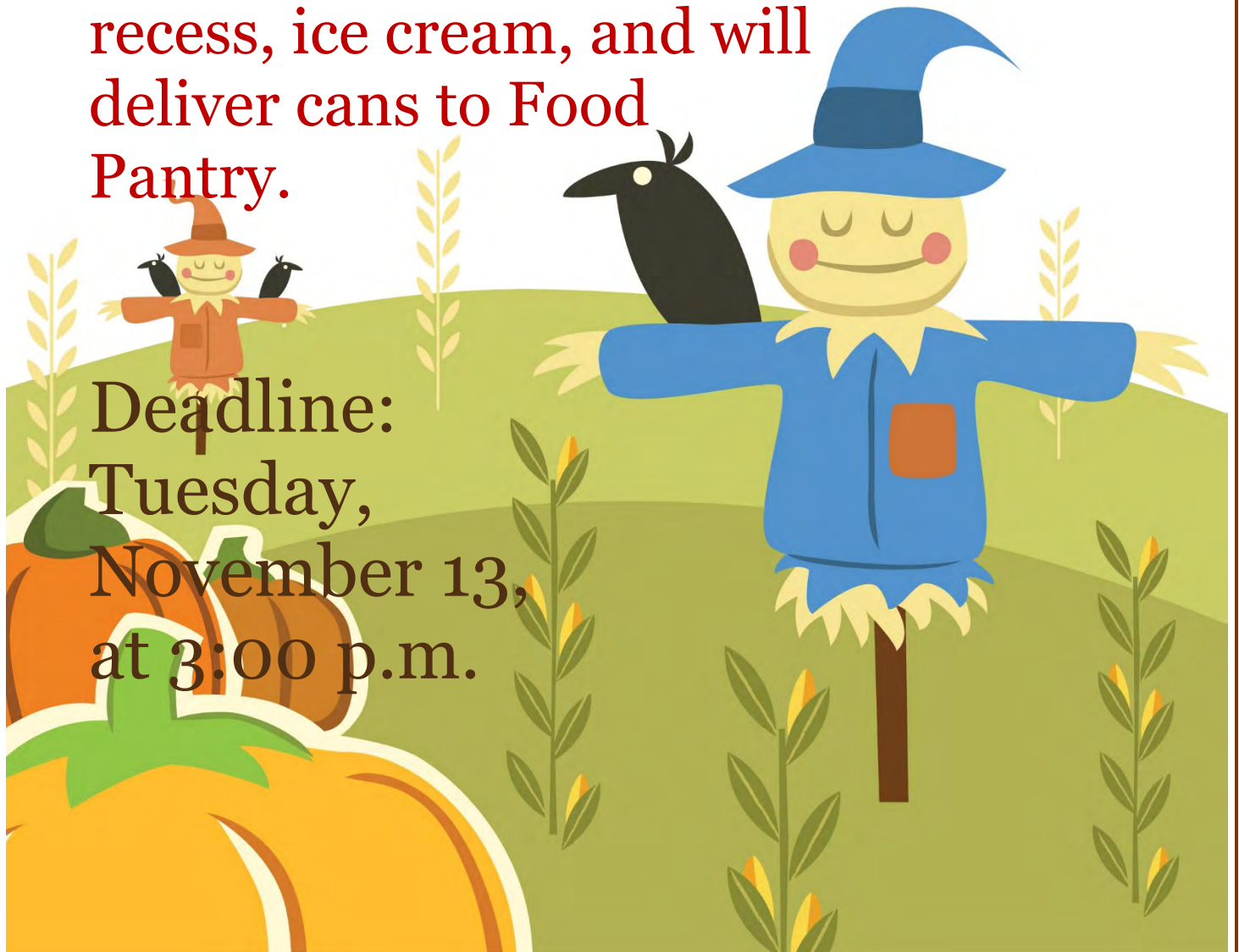
