**STL FLY:** The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs play the second game of a three-game weekend series from Wrigley Field tonight as the Cardinals wrap up their 10-game, three-city road trip through Colorado (1-3), San Francisco (2-1), and Chicago (0-1) leading into the All-Star Break ... St. Louis continues its stretch of 13 straight against San Francisco and Chicago over four consecutive series sandwiched around the All-Star Break ... St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central, 9.5 games behind Milwaukee.

**MOLINA HEADED TO 10TH ALL-STAR GAME:** Catcher **Yadier Molina** was named to his 10th career All-Star Game today, replacing Giants backstop **Buster Posey** (thumb injury) via the Player Ballot... Molina's 10 All-Star nods (2009-15, '17-18, '21) are most among all 2021 All-Stars, tied for 9th-most among catchers in MLB history, and tie **Enos Slaughter** for 4th-most in franchise history behind **Stan Musial** (24), **Ozzie Smith** (14), and **Ken Boyer** (11) ... Molina will celebrate the 91st Midsummer Classic on his 39th birthday, the second time in his career doing so after starting the 2010 exhibition in Anaheim (chart right).

**ARENADO, REYES, & OLSEN NAMED ALL-STARS:** **Nolan Arenado** was chosen by the fans to start at third base for the NL in the 2021 MLB All-Star Game, his 6th consecutive All-Star nod and his 4th straight fan election ... Arenado joins **Mike Schmidt** (6, 1979-84) and **Scott Rolen** (4, 2002-05) as the only NL third basemen with at least four consecutive fan-elected starting assignments ... Arenado becomes the 3rd Cardinals third baseman to garner a fan election, joining **Joe Torre** (1971-72) and **Rolen** (2003-05) ... The last Cardinals All-Star third baseman was **Matt Carpenter** (2016) and the last Cardinal to start an All-Star Game was shortstop **Jhonny Peralta** (2015) ... Closer **Alex Reyes** was selected by MLB and is the first Cardinals All-Star reliever since **Trevor Rosenthal** (2015) ... Cardinals Director of Medical Operations **Adam Olsen** was named to the NL All-Star Medical staff.

**CARDS AND CUBS:** The Cardinals and Cubs are facing off seven times over a 10-game stretch (July 9-22) ... St. Louis's 1-6 record against the Cubbies this season is its worst start since losing the first 12 games of the 1978 season series between the division rivals (STL finished 3-15).

**WRIGLEY NIGHTS:** The Cardinals and Cubs tonight play their 74th night game all-time at the Friendly Confines since lights were installed in 1988 ... The Cubs lead the series 47-28, with St. Louis 15-16 on Wrigley Nights since 2014.

**MOLINA MILESTONES:** **Yadier Molina** is one career hit away from reaching 2,064 and tying Hall of Famer **Enos Slaughter** (1938-53) for 5th all-time in Cardinals history, and one career double from 396 and tying Hall of Famer and Cubs great **Gabby Hartnett** (1922-41) for 5th all-time among primary catchers in MLB history ... Tonight is Molina's 225th career game at catcher versus the Cubs, passing Hall of Famer **Gary Carter** (1974-92) for 3rd all-time in MLB history.

**A-REY SAVES THE DAY:** **Alex Reyes** has nailed down 22 straight saves to begin his career (20-for-20 this season), tying **Tippy Martinez** for 2nd-most all-time in Major League history and one behind **LaTroy Hawkins** (23).

**GOLDY-LOCKS AND CUBBY BEARS:** Among active Major League leaders against the Cubs, **Paul Goldschmidt**, ranks 3rd in career slugging (.573) and OPS (.986), and 4th in batting average (.311) and on-base pct (.412) ... Goldy is currently enjoying a season-best nine-game hitting streak (14-37, .378) since June 30, T-3rd longest active in the National League.

**BECAUSE I SPIT HOT FIRE:** **Dylan Carlson**'s 38 walks this season are the most for a Cardinals rookie in franchise history before the All-Star Break (since 1933); **Solly Hemus** (75 walks in 1951) holds the Cardinals full season rookie walk record ... The 21-year-old Carlson has reached base safely 127 times this season, 3rd-most in Cardinals rookie history before the break behind Rookie of the Year winners **Wally Moon** (151 in 1954) and **Albert Pujols** (140 in 2001)

**BIRD SEED:** Tonight is the 49th road game for St. Louis this season, most in Major League Baseball and one fewer than the 2013 Cardinals for most in franchise history before the break (**Elias**) ... **Luis Garcia** yesterday became the 27th different Cardinals pitcher this season, 2nd-most in single-season franchise history behind the 30 Redbirds pitchers in 2018 ... The Cardinals will enter the All-Star Break with a record below .500 for only the 6th time since 1996.

**Tommy Edman** (junior) and **Nico Hoerner** (freshman) were teammates at Stanford Univ. in 2016.

**Mike Maddux**'s younger brother, **Greg Maddux**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06).

**Paul DeJong** graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

**Jason Heyward** played 2015 with St. Louis...traded by Atlanta with **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for **Tyrell Jenkins** and **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

**Joc Pederson**'s older brother, **Tyger Pederson**, is the hitting coach for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

As back-to-back compensation picks for the departures of **John Lackey** and **Jason Heyward** signing with Chicago in 2016, **Dylan Carlson** (No. 33) and **Dakota Hudson** (No. 34) were selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

**Patrick Wisdom** played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 MLB debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for **Octavio Dotel** signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 15th start of the season and 22nd career Major League start (23rd app.).
- Set to make his 6th start since returning from 10-day IL (lower back stiffness) that had sidelined him for eight games after departing his 6/4 start vs. CIN following just 3.0 IP.
- Is in the midst of his 15th season of professional baseball and his second with the Cardinals after playing 13 professional seasons in the KBO (Korean Baseball Organization).
- Is carrying a season-best 9.0 scoreless innings streak into tonight's game after balking the SF Giants in his last start for 7.0 IP.
- Has held the opposition to one or zero runs in 4 of his last 5 starts, posting a 2.39 ERA (26.1 IP/7 ER) in that 5-game span and a 1.23 mark in the four games w/1 or less runs.
- Walked a total of seven batters in his last four starts after walking a career-high five batters vs. Miami on June 15.
- Holding opponents to a .196 batting average with runners in scoring position, ranking 5th among National League pitchers; teammates John Gant (.125-1st) & Adam Wainwright (.200-7th) are also in the top-10.
- Has made 11 career day starts, going 2-2, 2.62 ERA (34.1 IP/10 ER), allowing just one HR, that coming off the bat of the D-Backs Ketel Marte on 5/30/21 at ARI.
- The Cardinals won each of his first five starts to begin 2021, but then dropped four straight before winning again on 6/15. They're 13-8 overall (.619 win pct.) in his 21 career appearances from 2020-21.
- Owns a 4-1 mark & 2.47 ERA (51.0 IP/14 ER) in 11 career appearances at Busch Std.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Blanked the Giants for 7.0 innings in a matchup with All-Star Kevin Gausman and came away with a 5-3 win. Allowed just three hits & won on the road for 1st time in 2021.

**2021 SEASON**

- Snapped a career-high five-game losing streak in 6/30 start vs. ARI. Was 1-for-1 with a two-RBI double and a sac bunt, becoming the first Cardinals left-handed pitcher with 2 RBI since Austin Gomber in 2018.
- Spent time on IL (lower back) for a 2nd time this season from June 5-15, missing 8 games. He'd also spent time on the IL after missing time in Spring Training and the first 17 games of the season with back ailment.
- Started 2nd game of double-header on 6/20 at ATL and allowed just one run (Acuna HR) and three hits in 4.0 IP, but Cardinals lost 1-0 for his 5th-straight defeat.
- Worked a then season-high 6.0 innings in his return from IL on 6/15 vs. MIA and held the Marlins to just one run on three hits despite walking a career-high five.
- Allowed a career single-game high 9 hits and 4 runs in a 9-2 loss at Arizona on 5/30.
- Hurlled 5.2 scoreless innings against the White Sox on 5/24 before giving up two-run HR and walk in the 6th inning, while throwing a career high 104 pitches.
- Kim's 2.85 career ERA in his first 17 career games was the lowest by a Cardinals left-handed pitcher (min. 75.0 IP) thru their first 17 career games since Donovan Osborne's 2.82 mark (1992).
- Compiled over 1,500 career strikeouts between the KBO (1,454) and MLB (48) when he struck out six batters at MIL (5/11), fanning Freddy Peralta for No. 1,500.
- Did not allow HR in 23.2 IP over five starts from 4/23, 6th inning to 5/24, 6th inning.
- Suffered first career MLB loss, lasting just 3.1 IP, in a 5-3 defeat vs. SD on May 16
