#STLFLY: The St. Louis Cardinals are playing the second of a three-game series against their N.L. Central Division rival Cincinnati Reds at Busch Stadium wrapping up their season series. Currently, the Cardinals are coming to the end of a seven-game homestand against the Dodgers (2-2) and Reds (Sept. 10-12). St. Louis began today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 15.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 3.0 games behind the 2nd Wild Card position held by San Diego with Cincinnati in their path.

SEEING RED: The Cardinals have lost five straight home games to the Reds dating back to June 3, marking their longest home losing streak to the Reds in Busch Stadium III history and since dropping seven straight to Cincinnati from Sept. 23, 1997-Sept. 4, 1998. The Cardinals longest losing streak at Busch Stadium III to any single opponent is six by three teams, most recently the Texas Rangers (2013-16), then Houston Astros (2010) and Milwaukee Brewers (2008)

WILD FINISH: The Cardinals are in the midst of four straight series against teams contending for the National League Wild Card. After splitting with the Los Angeles Dodgers, the Reds are in town this weekend, before St. Louis travels to Flushing to play the New York Mets and then return home to face the San Diego Padres net weekend.

SOSA POP! Since August 26, Cardinals infielder **Edmundo Sosa** leads all National League players with a .400 (16-40) batting average (**Bryce Harper**, 2nd, .393), hitting safely in 10 of his last 12 games played. Since the All-Star Break, Sosa leads all Cardinals batters with a .333 BA (30-90) ranking T-9th in Major League Baseball.

LUI...LUI: Relief pitcher **Luis García** (23.0-1st) owns the top active scoreless innings streak in Major League Baseball. García passed his career-high in scoreless innings on Thursday with two outs against the Dodgers. García 23.0 scoreless innings is T-5th in Major League Baseball this season (deGrom, NYM, 31.0 IP) and 3rd on the Cardinals (**Kwang Hyun Kim & Adam Wainwright**, 24.0 IP).

TWO YEAR ITCH: Starting pitcher **Miles Mikolas** is looking to earn his first win in almost exactly two years. Mikolas' last win came on Sept. 12, 2019 at Colorado in a 10-3 Cardinals win. Last season, Mikolas was on the Injured List the entire 2020 season and he missed 118 games on the Injured List this season.

FOUR SCORES AND 20 WINS AGO... Since joining the Cardinals in 2018, **Miles Mikolas** is 20-0 and the Cardinals are 27-2 when Mikolas receives four runs of support or more.

TERRIBLE TWOS: The Cardinals have been held to two runs or less in 49 games this season, 4th-most in Major League Baseball (Pirates 59, Rangers 51, Marlins 50). St. Louis has managed eight wins when scoring two or fewer runs this season, T-3rd most in MLB behind the Phillies (11) and Yankees (10).

FIRST FAMILY: First baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** leads the Cardinals and ranks 5th in the National League with 150 hits. Prior to Goldschmidt's arrival, the last Cardinals first baseman to record 150 hits was **Matt Adams** with 152 in 2014. Goldschmidt has tallied 150 or more hits in seven seasons throughout his career.

FIRST STATE, FIRST PLACE: Born in the state of Delaware, Cardinals first baseman **Paul Goldschmidt (1,545)** is four hits away from passing former Cardinal and current Cincinnati Reds first base coach **Delino DeShields (1,548)** for the all-time mark for hits by a player born in the "First State". Goldschmidt leads almost all other Delaware-born offensive categories including runs, doubles, home runs, RBI, walks, extra base hits.

FROM NOLAN TO ROLEN: **Nolan Arenado's** next blast will be his 30th of the season as he looks to become only the 4th Cardinals primary third baseman with a 30-homer season and first since **Scott Rolen** (34 in 2004) ... Arenado also seeks to become the second Major Leaguer joining **Nelson Cruz** with six 30-homer seasons since 2015, achieving the feat faster than **Manny Machado** (24 HR) who also has five seasons of 30+ homers from 2015-19.

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS: With 22 games remaining on the Cardinals schedule, St. Louis has 11 games at Busch Stadium. Since 2006, when the Cardinals opened Busch Stadium III, the 'Birds have the 4th-highest winning percentage at home in the month of September at 123-87 (.586), trailing only the New York Yankees (.630, 133-78), Los Angeles Dodgers (.617, 113-70) and Toronto Blue Jays (.597, 126-85). *Elias Sports Bureau*

FLIPPING THE SWITCH: **Dylan Carlson** has 123 hits this season, two behind current assistant coach **Willie McGee** (125) for 5th place all-time among Cardinals rookie switch-hitters. **Vince Coleman** (170) holds the record in 1985 with Hall of Famer **Red Schoendienst** (157), **Jimmy Brown** (145) and **Lee Magee** (133) remaining atop the list.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 6th start of the Major League season and his 5th since returning from the IL on August 20. Was sidelined May 22 until start on Aug. 20 by right forearm injury.
- Tonight marks his 80th career start (107th app.) and 70th start as a member of the Cardinals organization.
- Was activated from 60-day Injured List on 8/20 after right forearm tightness forced him to exit his first start of the season on 5/22 vs. CHI after four innings. He had begun the 2021 season on the Injured List after the same injury caused him to miss the entire 2020 season.
- Last recorded a win for the Cardinals almost exactly two years from this date on Sept. 12, 2019 in a day game at COL as Dexter Fowler and Kolten Wong hit back-to-back home runs to lead-off the game in a 10-3 victory.
- Is 6-2, 3.41 ERA in 12 September starts since joining St. Louis in 2018.
- Since beginning his stint with the Cardinals in 2018 (including missing the entire 2020 season and most of 2021), ranks 9th among Major League pitchers with 52 starts in which he issued one walk or less. Zack Greinke leads with 74 and Kyle Hendricks leads all N.L. pitchers with 67.
- Needs 2.2 innings pitched to reach 500 for his career.
- He made eight minor league starts this season during two rehab stints and posted an overall record of 3-1 with a 3.93 ERA covering 36.2 innings with only six walks.
- He made starts at Memphis-AAA (5), Springfield-AA (2) and Peoria-High A (1).
- Missed the entire 2020 regular season, and the beginning of 2021, as he continued recovery from right arm flexor tendon surgery.

LAST TIME OUT

- Drew the start on Mon. (9/6) in homestand opener against the Dodgers & Max Scherzer. Took the loss, allowing 4 runs on 4 hits in the opening inning. Allowed just one unearned run in his last 4.0 IP.

2021 SEASON

- Began the season on the Injured List recovering from right forearm tightness.
- Returned from the Injured List on May 22 to make a start vs. CHI and lasted only 4.0 innings before again returning to the Injured List with right forearm tightness.
- Made a total of eight rehab starts over his two stints on the Injured List and has made four Major League starts.
- Returned from the Injured List a second time and started at Busch Stadium vs. PIT (8/20) throwing a season-high 5.0 IP in a no-decision the Cardinals lost 4-0.
- Started the twinbill opener at Cincinnati last Wednesday, allowing four runs in 3.0 innings. Exited with St. Louis trailing 4-3 before the Cardinals quickly scored on Paul Goldschmidt's 2nd homer of the game, a two-run go-ahead shot in the 4th for a 5-4 win.
- He pitched in back-to-back starts against the Pirates and Mitch Keller in his first two starts following his second return from the Injured List.
