Dear Parishioners,

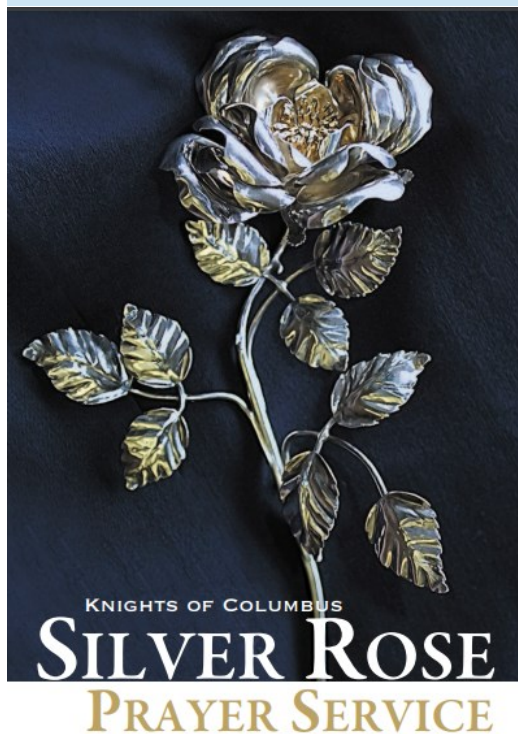
