Monday	Day 1 – The Princess and the Wizard	After listening to the story Handa's Surprise, ask your child to name and draw different fruits that they know. Label them using describing words. Maybe you could search together about where some fruit and different foods come from around the world?	Food Tasting- Find some different foods/fruits from around the world and taste each one. These might include pizza (Italy), curry (India) and taco (Mexican) or the fruits from the story Handa's Surprise. Your child can create a chart putting a tick next
Tuesday	Day 2 – The Princess and the Wizard	Your child can draw a picture of a suitcase and all the things they might take on holiday. Then encourage your child to write some sentences about why they have chosen those certain things to take.	to each food they like and a cross next to the foods they dislike over the course of the week.

Wednesday	Day 3 – The Princess and the Wizard	Ask your child to pretend they are on	
		holiday. Get them to make a postcard to send to someone at home. Ask your child to draw a picture of what they are doing on holiday. Can they write about what they have been doing there? (postcard templatewebsite)	Toys from Around the World- Look at this photography project of children with their toys from around the world. Discuss how life is the same and how life is different in other countries. Thursday	Day 4– The Princess and the Wizard	Watch the PowerPoint (website) about animals of the world. Does your child have a favourite? Can they write about which is their favourite and why?	Flags- Look at flags from around the world. Discuss which are your child's favourites and why? Ask your child to design and make their own flag using 2d shapes. https://www.worldomet ers.info/geography/flags-of-the-world/
Friday	Day 5 – The Princess and the Wizard	Look at different countries together. Then see if your child can write in sentences about a country they would like to visit and why? Find out some facts and information to help. The World

Virtual Tour- Visit the National History Museum in London and take a look around. You can find the virtual tour online.

Visit the Oak Academy site and learn about Africa or Australia! There is a little quiz first to see what you already know.

Where in the World? Discuss with your child where your family comes from in the world. If you have them available, show your child photographs of where you, or their grandparents, grew up. This might be similar to where they live now or completely different. Encourage your child to think about the differences between the places.

Literacy

Grown-ups write some sentences and miss words out. Can the children spot your mistake?

Act out a story – can you guess which one it was?

Guess the rhyme – read rhyming books and get the children to call out the words at the end of the sentence that rhyme.

Draw a picture of your family and write some sentences about them all and what you enjoy doing together.

Phonics games- Phase 2/3/4 – use Phonics Play and Phonics Bloom or Pinterest for ideas.

Build some DUPLO models and write post it notes about what you have created.
