"Eating a rainbow" helps your body get a complete range of nutrients. **The varieties of vitamins, minerals, antioxidants, and phytochemicals in colorful fruits and vegetables have enormous healing powers.** How many colors can you eat today??

Here's a recipe to try:

Rainbow Chili



1 zucchini, sliced

1 yellow squash, sliced

1 red bell pepper, diced

1 jalapeño pepper, minced (optional)

1 onion, diced

4 garlic cloves, minced

1 can crushed tomatoes with liquid

1 can tomato paste

1 can black beans

1 can chili beans

1 can whole kernel corn

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 tablespoon chili powder

½ teaspoon dried oregano

¼ teaspoon cayenne pepper

½ teaspoon ground black pepper

1. Heat oil in a large pot over medium-high heat. Stir in zucchini, yellow squash, bell pepper, jalapeño, onions and garlic. Sauté until tender (about 5 minutes). **2.** Add canned ingredients and reduce heat to a simmer. **3.** Stir in spices and simmer 45–60 minutes, stirring occasionally, until chili reaches desired consistency.
