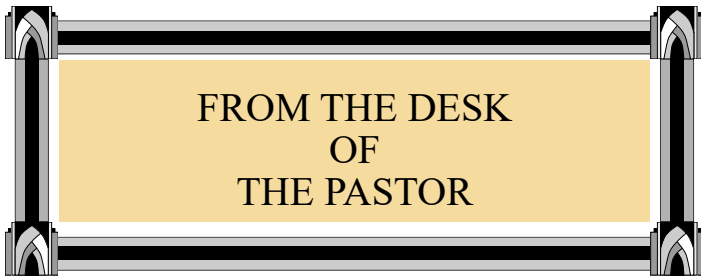

Dear Friends in Christ,

In our second reading from the second letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians, he writes:

"That I, Paul, might not become too elated. because of the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, an angel of Satan, to beat me, to keep me from being too elated. Three times I begged the Lord about this, that it might leave me, but he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness.'"

Great energy has gone into speculation about what Paul's "thorn" might have been. In general, this "thorn in the flesh," is widely interpreted to be a psychic or physical ailment, which, in Jewish tradition, was caused by a demon or Satan. It is possible that the community knew, but whether or not they did, Paul was not as concerned about what it was as with where it led him, what it did to and for him.

So, rather than tantalize his audience with the marvels he had experienced, Paul ultimately focused on his own weakness more than on anything else. .Whatever Paul's problem might have been, his first interpretation of it was that it had been effective in keeping him from thinking too much of himself; Paul wrote about both sides of his spiritual life in order to teach his community what spiritual life is all about. His own weakness or limitations were only obstacles to his mission, if the mission depended solely upon the natural abilities of St. Paul. But as it was, St. Paul accepted whatever limitations he had and allowed the grace of God to work through him. He cooperated with God's grace.

What great things can be brought about when we come to terms with the reality that God is God and we are not!

FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST

Mark's Gospel account today is built on a double astonishment or amazement: the neighbors and family of Jesus are astonished that he taught in the synagogue with wisdom and worked powerful signs. Jesus, in turn, is amazed that they have no faith in him because they know his origins, not because of any fault with his teaching or ministry. As with many of Mark's passages, we get a rather intimate glimpse here of the human part of Jesus' two-fold nature. To reinforce his point, Mark tells of Jesus' return to his native place, and further points out that he is in the midst of his own family members there. From the very people he expected the most, Jesus received the least. In the day of the Gospel's writing, Mark was attempting to illustrate a lesson to the house of Israel: the God of the covenant expected the greatest faith from the house of Israel, but often received the least. This is a good source for reflection on our part, we who are Jesus' followers today. For the wisdom of Christ to continue and for our lives to be seen as signs of his power, he must expect and be able to find great faith among us. Will he? Can he? Does he? Or is he, once again, amazed by its absence?
