

Many scholarships have been awarded over the years to those that have applied and met the requirements, which include young people as well as adults enrolled in or attending a college or university, technical school or seminary. The annual amount available for scholarships is based on the fund's earnings.

Applications are reviewed and rated each May by the St. Olaf according Scholarship Committee the guidelines and are awarded in early June.

WELCA embraces all kinds of ministries that support our mission of mobilizing women to act boldly on their faith in Jesus Christ. Good News!

There is a place for you in Women of Grace at St. Olaf and Women of the ELCA. Bible Study and Service are the primary activities of Women of Grace. Additionally, we plan some fun activities and outings occasionally and offer members and guests opportunities to get out and participate outside of our church home. We meet on the 2nd Monday of the month at 6:00 p.m. and all are welcome to attend.

This spring, we are offering two opportunities to get out and have some fun! The first opportunity is a musical event. On Saturday, April 1, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. or 7:30 p.m., at the Schauer Center in Hartford, The Next Generation Leahy will perform. Building on over three generations of Leahy musicianship, Doug Leahy, his wife Jennifer and their children are keeping those traditions alive through music, song and dance. Led by Doug, live performances are filled with the high-energy, infectious, Celtic-based music associated with the Leahy heritage. Fiddle, cello, French accordion, singing, piano and Fred-Canadian step-dancing all find a voice onstage. Please consider attending this exciting and entertaining program. The cost is \$65 per person. The Women of Grace will defray that cost by \$20 per person. A sign-up sheet will be available in the gathering area. Again, this is not for women only! All are welcome!
