## Live Each Day Preparing for Eternity

January 24, 2021

Given all the events of the past many months, we don't need a prophet to remind us that this world won't last forever. St. Paul tells us, the world in its present form is passing away. Jesus may return any moment at the end of time, but if it's not during our lifetime, every one of us will one day die. If we've repented all along in our lives, seeking God's forgiveness for our sins, believed in the Gospel, and did the best we could to follow Jesus, then, God willing, we'll see the Kingdom of God, and enjoy eternal life.

So, if heaven is our goal, then how should we act? This weekend's Sacred Scriptures offer us with a few practical suggestions.

We can learn from the example of the Ninevites that we should recognize our own sinfulness, repent, and seek forgiveness. This is important not only because it is "right and just", but also because it's an exercise in humility. For Christians, humility may be defined as "The virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the creator of all good. "Humility" avoids unwarranted ambition or pride and provides us with "the foundation of prayer (CCC #2559)". Therefore, if we can find humility, it will help us grow in holiness.

What St. Paul is telling us, basically, is that we must act in just the opposite way as a person would expect. We understand this to mean we should keep our focus *not* on the things and events of *this world*, but rather *on heaven*. We need to live each day knowing that, hopefully, we're preparing our souls to live in heaven with our Lord and Savior, along with all the saints and angels.

Finally, we see in this weekend's Gospel that Jesus tells us simply to repent and believe in the Gospel. He invites the first disciples, Simon, and Andrew, to follow him. They do, and so also do James and John. We're taught by this Gospel that faith includes actively following Christ, even if that means leaving the good things of this world behind. This self-sacrifice isn't easy, on us or sometimes on those we love. But following our Lord Jesus Christ is the most important thing we can possibly do in our lives.

Therefore, let us ask Jesus to help us to always remember to keep our eyes fixed on heaven, because this world in its present form is passing away.

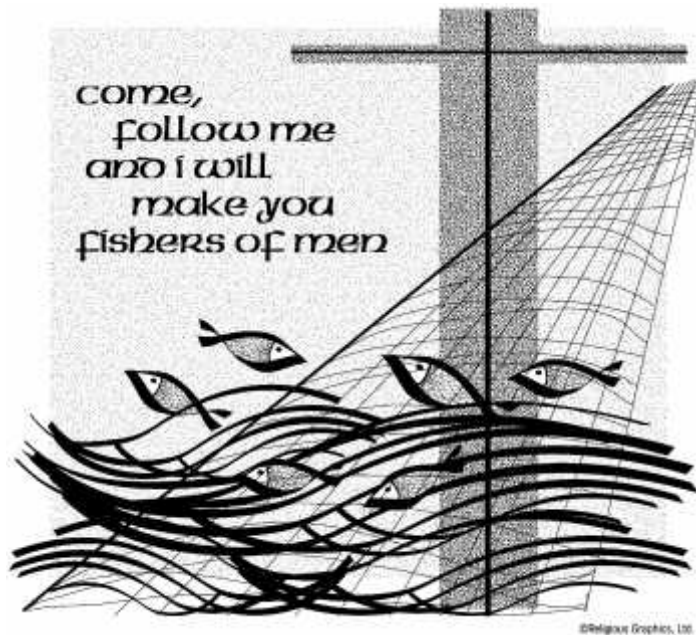

St. Philip's is introducing a new system called "My Own Church." It allows you to manage your family in-




### To create your My Own Church Account:

1. Go to [stphilipsbemidji.org](http://stphilipsbemidji.org)
2. Click on the My Own Church Button (It will appear in the banner images or scroll down the page.)
3. Click "New User"
4. Scroll down to select "St. Philip's, Bemidji" in the "Organization" field
5. Create a "User Name."
6. Create an account. (Accounts need to be verified by church staff, so you will not have immediate access. Accounts should be approved within one business day.) Please note, the system will attempt to match the email you input to an existing account. We may have an old email. You can update all contact information when you access your account.
7. After your account is approved, you will have access to your family's information!

Check out My Own Church soon to download your 2020 Year-End Giving Contribution Statement. (We will mail statements by January 31 for families that have not accessed statements online.)

### To Access Year-End Contribution Letters Online:

1. Go to [stphilipsbemidji.org](http://stphilipsbemidji.org)
2. Click on the "My Own Church" button
3. Log in to the account you created.
4. Click . In the **Quick Links** section, select the **My Own Church** link.
5. Select the **My Offering** tab.
6. Click  to display the **Giving History** page.
7. In the **Filter Options** section, select filters to narrow down the transactions you want to include in the statement:
  - A. **Funds:** to view giving to a specific fund, select the fund from the list. Or, select **All** to include all funds.
  - B. **Years:** to view annual contributions for a specific year, select the year from the list.
  - C. **Tax Deductible:** select the checkbox to include tax-deductible contributions only.
  - D. **Include Member Information:** select the checkbox to include individual family member's giving information.
8. Click . Select the **Statement** link.
9. The **Save** dialog box opens.
10. Open the file or save it to your computer.
11. If desired, print the statement.

**Please Note:** At this time, pledge gifts appear in the year-end contribution statement, but under Pledges, the message "No data available" may appear. We are working to correct this problem.
