## This Week's Reflection

### One Small Step

In today's Gospel, we see the Samaritan woman coming to faith. The steps she takes are our steps, too. Though she needs Jesus' help, he approaches her first. He invites us to make the journey of faith long before we start, by putting us into a faithful family, giving us a curious heart that seeks the truth, sending us a friend or spouse whose example draws us to the Lord.

The next step is acknowledging our need and our sinfulness. Admitting our need for God, and especially for God's forgiveness, opens us to God's saving grace. Another step is drawing closer to God in prayer. Jesus tells the woman, and us, that the best worship is honest and from the Spirit.

When we begin to share our faith with others, we take the step of living our faith. Like the woman who told her neighbors about Jesus, we find that the people we have touched begin to find the Lord on their own. Our catechumens are taking these steps now, thanks to those who have helped them experience Jesus' invitation to faith.

## Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma

### COMPRUEBALO

¿Qué se requiere para convencernos de la verdad? Algunos de nosotros simplemente necesitamos escuchar que alguien con cierta autoridad lo diga. Otros necesitan tiempo para pensar un argumento que los convenza, paso a paso. Muchos de nosotros tendemos a aprender de una forma difícil, experimentando las lecciones de la vida en formas dramáticas y personales. Varios tipos de evidencia funcionan diferentemente en nosotros. Para los israelitas nómadas y sedientos, una fuente de agua los persuade a volver a creer en Dios. Él nos recuerda lo inusual que es para las buenas personas sacrificarse a sí misma por otras personas; es completamente absurdo para una buena persona dar su vida por los "impíos" y pecadores. Y eso fue precisamente lo que Jesús hizo por nosotros.

Nuestra insaciable necesidad de una prueba no es algo por

que avergonzarse. El hambre por evidencia indica un intelecto activo. Aún después de aprender una verdad importante, necesitamos alimentar nuestro conocimiento a través de nuestras vidas. Muchos de nosotros primeros escuchamos acerca de Jesús cuando éramos niños. Debemos seguir profundizando nuestro entendimiento al tiempo que maduramos. De manera similar, los primeros samaritanos creyeron a su paisana (la mujer samaritana) simplemente porque su testimonio acerca de Jesús. Luego, después de que ellos encontraron a Jesús, se convencen que Jesús es el salvador del mundo: "No creemos por lo que tú nos dijiste, sino por que lo hemos escuchado nosotros mismos y sabemos que es verdaderamente el salvador del mundo". La experiencia personal confirma y profundiza su fe. El salmista nos dice: "No endurezcan su corazón". Continuemos aprendiendo de todas las señales de Dios alrededor nuestro

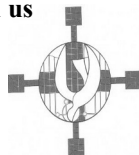


