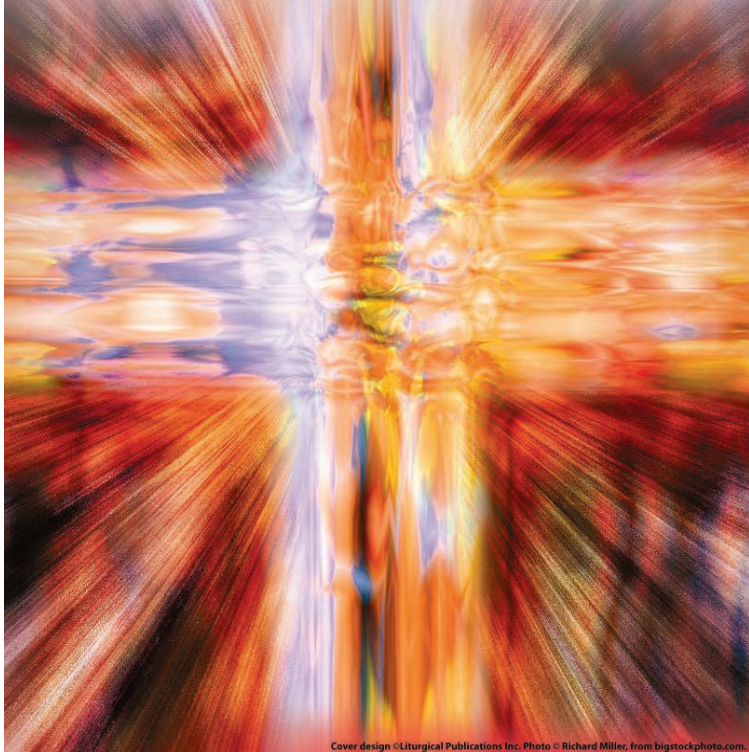

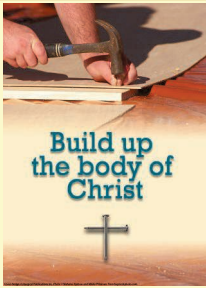

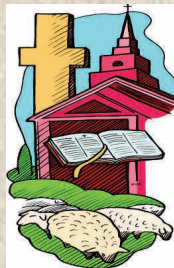

INTRODUCTION TO TODAY'S READINGS

As the Easter season ends, we celebrate a whole new beginning: the Spirit-filled disciples of Jesus begin their apostolate to witness to the risen Christ. The task did not end with the Twelve, our apostolate is that same witness, that same making visible the presence of Christ in today's world.



First Reading Acts 2:1-11

On the final day of Passover, Jesus' disciples receive the Holy Spirit in a way that recalls the giving of the Law to the Israelites at Mount Sinai.

Second Reading Galatians 5:16-25

The fruits of the Holy Spirit are so much different from other fruits. Only the Holy Spirit can bring the fruits of love, peace, patience, and gentleness.

Gospel John 15:26-27; 16:12-15

The Holy Spirit, the Advocate, will be Jesus' witness when he comes and, through the Spirit, Jesus' followers also become his witnesses.

QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK - LET US REFLECT AND RESPOND TO SCRIPTURE

First Reading—We hear today about the descent of the Holy Spirit onto the Apostles and the birth of the Church. What do you think the miracle of Pentecost means for believers today?

Second Reading - Paul implores the Christians in the region of Galatia to "live by the Spirit." Where do you see your faith community living by the Spirit?

Gospel Reading—Once again this Sunday we hear from Jesus' farewell discourse to the Disciples where Jesus foreshadows the coming of the Holy Spirit. Why do you think Jesus refers to the Holy Spirit as our "Advocate" and "the Spirit of truth"?

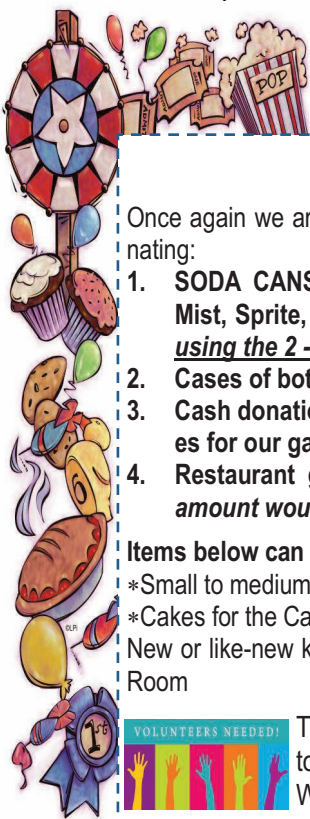
Once again we are asking parishioners to help cut the Bazaar expenses by donating:

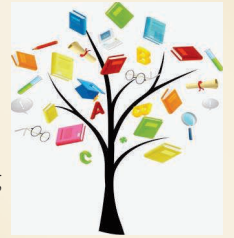

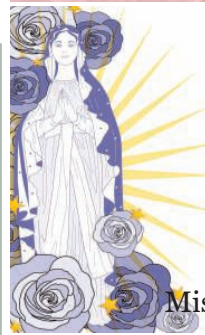

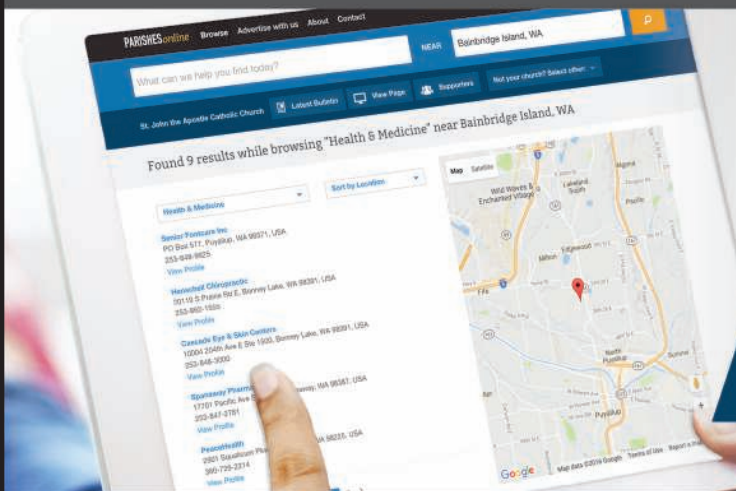
