

Obituary St. Richard's Furnace Born in 1966 Died July 2019


Surrounded by loving family, good friends, parishioners and parish pastor.



I am pleased to inform you that our parish now has a solution to make donating simple and easy, while at the same time keeping the process safe and secure. **Beginning today, online giving will be available for parishioners who would like to donate to our Furnace** / **AC fund**, or weekly offerings as well, without writing a check or turning in a paper form.

We are working with WeShare, a Liturgical Publications Inc company; a publisher of communication tools for churches for almost forty years. LPi demonstrates the highest security standards, and we are excited to partner with them.

Our new Online Giving system will allow you to make your donations without writing any checks or needing to remember to bring your envelope to church each week. You can set up a recurring weekly or monthly payment, allocate different amounts for different funds, and view complete, accurate financial records at any time. You even have the option to print donation slips if you would still like something to put in the collection basket each Sunday. Making changes can be done from your own home without the need to send paperwork to the parish office. No information about your bank or credit card accounts passes back and forth on paper, making the process private and secure. And, it saves all of us time so is a win-win for our parish.

Those who wish to continue to use traditional methods of offering may do so, however, we ask that you prayerfully consider making the change to this electronic giving solution. Q: Which payment methods are accepted?


A: WeShare has the ability to accept contributions from checking accounts, savings accounts, debit cards, or major credit cards such as Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.

Q: Do parishioners receive receipts for their donations?

A: Yes, all contributors enrolled with We Share can elect to receive receipts via e-mail.

Q: Is WeShare safe?

A: Yes. WeShare is certified with the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standards (DSS) as a Level 1 Service Provider. We implement the safest security standards for online transactions—your account information is immediately encrypted to ensure absolute financial security. 
