

you have put all my sins behind your back.


For the grave cannot praise you, death cannot sing your P R A I S E;

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend at all Liturgies we are going to pray the Anaphora of Saint John Chrysostom, Doctor of the Church and in many ways the pride of the Eastern Liturgies. John Chrysostom was from the school of Antioch and a colleague of Saint Maron. We rarely use his Anaphora because of his 'length'. In all honesty, it only adds six minutes to the Liturgy.

The beauty of that Anaphora is that it gives you an overall explanation of the plan of Salvation of Christ. In other words, it covers every aspect from the Incarnation through the life of Christ emphasizing His salvific mission, life, suffering, death and resurrection.

By not using that beautiful Anaphora more often, I feel as if I am being neglectful in offering a more diverse understanding of our rich heritage. It has led me to the need of more Adult catechesis on a parish level for a deeper understanding of our Maronite Antiochine Church.

I would like to announce that our focus this New Liturgical Year will center around the theme of our "Heritage and Roots". We need to get back to basics my dear people. Our Heritage has always been based on a family, the family of Beit Maroun. In that family we see a church that has survived despite the various attacks and persecutions it has endured, spiritual, theological and cultural.

I pray that this New Year bring us ever closer to the one person who means everything to us, our Lord, Jesus Christ. Happy New Year and many blessings to all of you.
