Fr. Del's Point to Ponder

Last Sunday of the Liturgical Year: Christ the King

Today we end our Liturgical Year on this Solemnity of Christ the King, a good reminder that from start to finish, it is God who is, ultimately, in charge. We end this year, and prepare for the new year next Sunday, the beginning of Advent. New beginnings are always a moment of grace, may we be especially graced in our belief that the final word is always God's. In the middle of St. Peter's square in Rome, there stands a great obelisk. It is about four and a half thousand years old and it originally stood in the temple of the sun in the Egyptian city of Heliopolis. But it was brought to Rome by the dreadful Emperor Caligula and it was set right in the middle of the Circus of Nero, equally dreadful, that was on the Vatican hill. It was in that Circus that St. Peter was martyred, and the obelisk may well have been the last thing on this Earth that Peter saw. On top of the obelisk, there now stands a cross. In ancient times there was a gold ball representing, of course, the sun. Now there is a cross however, the cross of Christ, and on the pedestal of the obelisk there are two inscriptions. The first of them in Latin, "Christus vincit, Christus regnat, Christus imperat," which translated means, Christ has conquered, Christ now rules, Christ now reigns supreme. The other inscription, "The Lion of Judah has conquered." So here we have the language of victory. Christianity has triumphed by the power of the cross and triumphed over even the greatest power that the ancient world had known, the Roman Empire, and here in the middle of St. Peter's square stands the obelisk bearing those triumphant inscriptions. - Donations that are made through the **#GiveCatholicAOC** portal in advance of December 1st or are brought in or mailed to the parish office will not be included in the program and will be assessed by the Archdiocese.
- You can make your donation through the **#GiveCatholicAOC** portal using your debit card, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express, or you can donate via electronic check (ACH).
- The Archdiocese will not assess donations made through the #GiveCatholicAOC portal the full amount of your gift will go to St. Veronica, minus the transaction fees. Credit and debit card fees range between 1.4% and 2.9% depending on the type of card used; ACH (electronic) fees are .4% plus .38¢ per transaction.
- There is no minimum or maximum donation amount all gifts will be applied to the offertory and are welcomed and very much appreciated.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

The Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation or Confession) is celebrated each Saturday, 2:30-3:30 p.m., or by appointment with the pastor. Seasonal Penance Services are also celebrated.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick may be scheduled by calling the pastor before a medical procedure, or in the event of a serious illness. When hospitalized, please notify the Parish Office; this is the only way we know if a parishioner has been hospitalized. In case of medical emergency or death, call the parish office and follow prompts.

SACRAMENTS OF COMMITMENT

The Sacrament of Marriage is scheduled by calling the pastor or deacon to begin the process of marriage preparation, at least six months prior to the anticipated wedding date. A date for the wedding is set only after meeting with the pastor or deacon.

Discernment for the Sacrament of Orders (ordination to the Priesthood and Diaconate) is facilitated by contacting the pastor or Vocation Director of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Those interested in pursuing Religious Life may also make these contacts.
