## Feast of St Junipero Serra

July 1 is the Feast of St Junipero Serra, OFM, Patron Saint of Vocations to Church ministry is the only saint to be canonized on American Soil. This happened by Pope Francis on Sept. 23, 2015, in Washington, D.C. Join us in prayer on Wednesday July 1 that some of our students and alumni are called and graciously accept their call to the holy priesthood and religious life.

A prayer from our first Bishop in the United States, Bishop Carroll:

*We pray, O almighty and eternal God, who through Jesus Christ has revealed thy glory to all nations, to preserve the works of your mercy, that your Church, being spread through the whole world, may continue with unchanging faith in the confession of your name. We pray Thee, who*

*alone are good and holy, to endow with heavenly knowledge, sincere zeal and sanctity of life, our chief bishop, the pope, the vicar of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the government of his Church; our own bishop, all other bishops, prelates and pastors of the Church; and especially those who are appointed to exercise among us the functions of the holy ministry, and conduct your people into the ways of salvation. We pray O God of might, wisdom and justice, through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with your Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude the president of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness and be eminently useful to your people over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality.*

Bishop John Carroll, Archbishop of Baltimore first Bishop in the United States in the first diocese, written November 10 1791.

### Credible allegation against priest formerly assigned to St. Patrick

On June 24, 2020, the Archdiocese of St. Louis informed the Diocese of Jefferson City it has found substantiated allegations of sexual misconduct with minors by Father John C. Condit. Father Condit served at St. Patrick in Sedalia in 1973.

He also served at Sts. Peter and Paul in Boonville from 1973-1977, St. Joseph in Fayette in 1977, and St. Francis Xavier in Taos, 1977-1994.

As a Church, we are committed to a safe, healthy and holy environment for our children. If anyone is aware of any inappropriate behavior toward our children or vulnerable adults, please contact the appropriate Missouri state hotline:

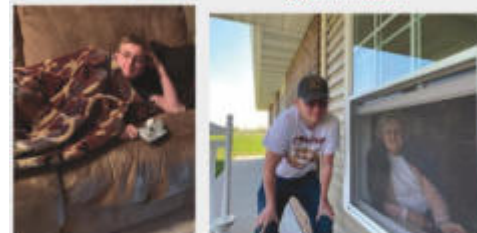
