A Message From Our Pastor

Today on the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, we celebrate the great gift of the Eucharist, the gift of that sacred meal which we share together with one another every weekend. In the gospel the words that Jesus spoke to his disciples at the last supper, "This is my body, this is the cup of the new covenant," are the same words that we hear in every Eucharistic Prayer. To them are added words that Christ spoke according to Paul, "Do this in memory of me." It is that command of Christ's on which I wish to focus today, that command that we do this meal in memory of him.

Christ asks us to remember, but what does he ask us to remember? Certainly he asks us to remember his words at the last supper but I think he asks us to remember much more than that. By joining this Eucharistic meal to the command to remember, Jesus makes the Eucharist the antidote to forgetfulness. Our lives are diminished over and over again by the things we forget. We are so busy, so preoccupied with so many things that we often end up forgetting the things that are essential. We are so focused on raising our children, in negotiating problems at work or getting through the fear of an economic downturn. We forget to take strength from the things that can truly give us life. It is all so easy to focus on things which are marginal and forget those things that are fundamental. In that forgetfulness, we keep going faster and faster and our lives become more and more superficial because we sever ourselves from the beauty and the mystery of living.

Against this kind of forgetfulness, Jesus asks us to remember Him and His ways of love as we celebrate this meal in memory of him.

This weekend we are all holding in sacred remembrance the 20 years of devoted ministry Deacon John Slatcoff has given to our parish family. We recall with gratitude the life of service and devotion he, together with his wife Cookie, have lavished upon our community. Bravo ! Bravo !

May the generous Master Jesus one day give to all his faithful servants life and endless love in the banquet halls of heaven.
