With its almost human sound the product of its small bore, his trumpet is an ideal vocal partner and, together, Curtis and Richardson gave terrific readings of Handel's 'Let the Bright Seraphim' and Bach's cantata 'Jauchzet Gott.'" Joan Reinthaler wrote in the *Washington Post* about a collaborative concert with the Countertop Ensemble and the Washington Cornett and Sackbut Ensemble: "The 'cornett' in the instrumental ensemble bears almost no relation to the modern cornet. Dating from the 15th century, it is slightly bent, usually made of wood with finger holes like a recorder's and a mouthpiece a little like a trumpet's. He gave clear direction to every note, from soaring solo lines to small ideas he connected into long, arched phrases.... Curtis was also heard in Bach's 'Jauchzet Gott in allen Landen,' with soprano Jennifer Gettel. Curtis and Gettel deftly traded phrases, matching interpretive details and dynamics nicely.
