An interesting combination, but not necessarily an easy relationship. As for role playing, Wilbur will have to assume the role of the loved one, the object of love, and Charlotte the role of provider and lover. Charlotte should have no trouble caring for Wilbur, since she naturally is more responsible, receptive, naturally aware, and has vision and strong mental qualities. Charlotte has a strong sense of compassion and the will to do something about it, to make ideas matter in the day-to-day world.

The problem here is that, although Wilbur loves, deserves, and is used to being given a lot of attention, Charlotte also has some of this same need. In addition to all of her natural sense of responsibility, Charlotte requires some looking after too. This is where heads may bump, because both can't be waited on at once.

Also, while Wilbur is, by nature quite used to and dependent on relationships, Charlotte is not, and, by type, is much more self-sufficient and independent. In other words, Charlotte is not as reliant on relationships or partnerships in general, and quite content to be by herself. Charlotte may have an almost obsessive trait of single-minded concentration on whatever she is doing, and this may take up a lot of time. Both partners here could benefit from outside advice and direction, in particular Wilbur.

Lovers Comparison



This relationship has some promise, provided a few rules be observed or kept in mind. Rule number one is that Charlotte only plays one role, and that is the role of the loved one, the object of affection. She does not do the lover role, so take note. She just is not constructed to look after care-take, or tend to others, but is used mostly to being tended to, taken care of.

With Wilbur, he can go both ways, acting out the role of the lover or becoming the object of love, the loved one. It all depends on what his partner requires, although it is probably easier for his to be the loved one, and just get the attention.

But in order for this relationship to work, Wilbur will have to be the lover and just suck it up when it comes to getting very much attention himself. If he can get behind this, the relationship will thrive. If not, both partners will compete for attention, with no one wanting to do the caring for, the loving. The result will be a weakening of the relationship.

The Inner Relationships



These two certainly understand one another for in many ways they are cut from the same cloth, although Charlotte is probably the more reasonably of the two. Still, their chances of butting heads from time to time are about 100%, because both tend to be selfish, like and demand attention, consider themselves the darling of any group. Wilbur is especially this way, and Charlotte will have to learn to live with this.

Over time Wilbur will probably come to depend on Charlotte for advice and counsel, because of the two, she is more the thinker and reasoned. Wilbur tends to act first and then think about it, while Charlotte can sometimes think before acting. Both are impulsive types. Socially they fit in well, with Charlotte being more the talker of the two of them. As mentioned, both can be high-maintenance types, liking at least their share of attention, if not more.

All in all this combination makes for a bit of a bumpy road friendship-wise, and problems will at times dominate. They are perhaps too similar and sames repel.



Profile Summary for Charlotte
