GAME SUMMARY

The Minnesota Vikings (0-1) are heading back on the road for a matchup against the Arizona Cardinals (1-0) with the game set for 3:05 p.m. CT at State Farm Stadium. The matchup marks the 29th contest between the two franchises and the 8th in Arizona.

Minnesota last played at Arizona in 2015 - Mike Zimmer's second season as head coach of the Vikings - when the club finished the season as NFC North Champions. Arizona is coming off of a 38-13 road-win against Tennessee, the team's first season opener road game against an AFC opponent since 1997. The Vikings return back on the road after an overtime loss at Cincinnati.

The Vikings' wide receivers got off to a strong Week 1 start. WR's **Adam Thielen**, **Justin Jefferson** and **K.J. Osborn** all recorded 70 or more receiving yards against the Bengals, making them the only wide receiver trio in the NFL to do so in Week 1.

S **Harrison Smith** extended his team record for most sacks by a DB to 14.5. LB **Eric Kendricks'** 15 tackles in Week 1 are the most in a Week 1 game and his second-most in his career. In their debuts with the Vikings, **NT Michael Pierce** and **LB Nick Vigil** both recorded sacks. Pierce had a career day, finishing with the most single-game sacks of his career (2.0), while Vigil has posted a sack in his last three-of-four games.

NORSEMAN NOTEABLES

- WR **Justin Jefferson** became the first Vikings WR to complete a pass in a single game since Sidney Rice vs. Oakland, 11/18/2007. He also became the first to attempt a pass since Stefon Diggs vs. Green Bay, 12/23/2019. His first career pass resulted in WR **K.J. Osborn's** first career reception.
- NT **Michael Pierce** set a career high in sacks (2.0) and tied a career high in tackles for loss (2.0) and total tackles (7). His last full sack was the 2017 season opener at Cincinnati.
- S **Harrison Smith** extended his team record for most sacks by a DB to 14.5. Joey Browner ranks second with 9.5.
- WR **Adam Thielen** recorded the 40th and 41st touchdown receptions of his career.
- QB **Kirk Cousins** moved into a tie for the fourth-most starts by a Vikings QB with his 48th. Cousins became the first Vikings QB to start four straight season openers since Daunte Culpepper 2002-05.
- LB **Eric Kendricks'** 15 tackles marked the second-most in his career - his most since Week 13 in 2018 when he had 16 tackles against the New England Patriots. Kendricks' total tackles are the most in a Week 1 game and since Ed McDaniel in 2000 against the Bears.
- TE **Tyler Conklin** has caught at least three passes in five-straight games, which ranks sixth among active tight ends.

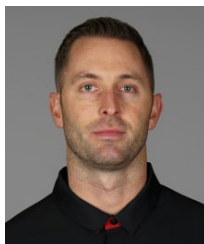

Kliff Kingsbury was named Arizona's head coach on January 8, 2019 when he signed a four-year contract with a team option for a fifth. The 42-year old Kingsbury came to Arizona after spending six seasons (2013-18) as the head coach at his alma mater, Texas Tech. The New Braunfels, TX native is a 13-year coaching veteran who also spent three seasons (2003-05) in the NFL as a player.

ARIZONA: In his first two seasons with the Cardinals, Kingsbury has led a turnaround resulting in a two-win improvement following his first year in 2019 and a three-win improvement after his second season in 2020. Arizona went from having the NFL's 32nd ranked offense in 2018 to the 16th ranked offense in 2019 and the 6th ranked offense in 2020.

Kingsbury has completely transformed the Cardinals offense in his first two seasons at the helm. Last year, Arizona finished top-10 in total offense (#6), rushing yards/game (#7), rushing TDs (#4) and offensive TDs (#10) while compiling 6,153 total net yards, the third most in team history and scoring 411 points, the fifth most in franchise history. The Cardinals have put up 400+ net yards in a game 13 times in two seasons under Kingsbury - including in eight games in 2020. Only five teams had more games with 400+ yards in the last two seasons.

After ranking 31st in the NFL with just four games of 25+ points in the two seasons (2017-18) prior to his arrival, Arizona ranks 7th in the NFL with 18 such performances under Kingsbury. Arizona had a streak of five consecutive games with 30+ points and 400+ total yards in 2020 (Games 5-9). It was the longest such streak in franchise history and the longest for any team in the league since Denver set an NFL record with 10 straight games in 2012-13.

In his first season in 2019, Kingsbury helped Arizona boast a 60.4% increase in points scored

and a 91.7% increase in the total number of scoring drives compared to 2018.

Arizona has also featured one of the NFL's top rushing attacks the past two years. The NFL's 32nd ranked run game in 2018, the Cardinals had the 10th ranked run game in 2019 and the 7th ranked rushing attack in 2020. In two seasons under Kingsbury, Arizona has rushed for 4,227 yards and 40 TDs, joining Baltimore, Tennessee, San Francisco and New Orleans as the only five teams in the NFL to have rushed for 4,000+ yards and 40+ TDs during that span.

The Cardinals rushed for 2,237 yards and 22 TDs in 2020. It marked just the sixth time in franchise history - and first time since 1984 - that Arizona had 2,000+ rushing yards and 20+ rushing TDs in a season. In 2019, Arizona established a franchise single-season record with a 5.03-yard rushing average as a team.

Under Kingsbury's tutelage, Arizona QB Kyler Murray - the #1 overall pick in the 2019 NFL Draft - was selected to his first Pro Bowl last year after he was named AP NFL Offensive Rookie of the Year in 2019. The former Heisman Trophy winner started all 16 games for the second consecutive season in 2020 and set a franchise record for completion percentage (67.2) while also setting franchise QB records for rushing yards (819) and rushing TDs (11) in a season.

TEXAS TECH: Kingsbury spent six seasons as the head coach at Texas Tech where he also called the plays for the Red Raiders high-powered offense that annually ranked among the top units in the country.

The Red Raiders featured a passing attack that ranked in the top-10 in the country in all six seasons of Kingsbury's tenure, ranked in the top-20 nationally for total offense in all six seasons and finished in the top-25 in scoring five times. In 2016, Texas Tech led the nation in total offense (566.6 ypg), passing offense (463.0 ypg) and ranked fifth in scoring offense (43.7 ppg).

Under Kingsbury, Texas Tech averaged at least 30 points per game, 470 total yards per game and 300 passing yards per game in all six seasons. The Red Raiders averaged over 500 yards of offense in four seasons and over 450 passing yards twice. In 24 games against ranked opponents, the Red Raiders offense averaged 502 ypg.

Kingsbury's star pupil at Texas Tech was QB Patrick Mahomes, who was selected 10th overall in the 2017 NFL Draft and has earned 2018 NFL MVP Honors and Super Bowl LIV MVP honors in his first

four seasons in league. Mahomes helped rewrite the history books during his tenure with the Red Raiders, eclipsing the 5,000-yard mark as a junior in 2016 to become just the third quarterback ever to record 5,000+ yards of total offense in back-to-back seasons. He was selected as the 2016 Sammy Baugh Award winner after leading the country in passing yards (5,052) while throwing for 41 TDs and rushing for 285 yards and 12 TDs. Mahomes became the second of Kingsbury's quarterbacks to lead the nation in passing yards, joining former Houston QB Case Keenum (2009, '11).

As a sophomore in 2015, Mahomes became the youngest quarterback in NCAA history to amass 5,000 yards of total offense (4,653 passing yards; 456 rushing yards) and accounted for 46 TDs (36 passing, 10 rushing). Texas Tech finished #2 in the nation in total offense (579.5 ypg), passing offense (388.2 ypg) and scoring (45.1 ppg). The Red Raiders were one of just two schools nationally to score 25 or more points in every game that season.

In 2015, the Red Raiders featured a 4,000-yard passer, 1,000-yard receiver and a 1,000-yard rusher for the first time in school history. WR Jakeem Grant had 1,268 receiving yards to set the school career receiving yardage record (3,164 yards), breaking the previous mark held by two-time Biletnikoff Award winner Michael Crabtree. Grant also broke the school single-season record for allpurpose yards (2,353) and career kick return TDs (4).

RB DeAndre Washington had back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons (2014-15), becoming the first Red Raider since Doak Walker award winner Byron Hanspard (1995-96) to accomplish that feat.

In his first year at Texas Tech in 2013, Kingsbury's offense finished 2nd nationally in passing offense (392.8 ypg) and 8th in total offense (510.7 ypg) and beat #16 Arizona State in the Holiday Bowl. He became just the second coach in program history to win a bowl game in his first season. Kingsbury had 12 players named to either the All-Big 12 first or second team as well as three All-America selections during his tenure at Texas Tech. He also helped eight players get selected in the NFL Draft.

QUARTERBACK SUCCESS: In addition to helping guide Kyler Murray to a record-breaking start to his NFL career, Kingsbury tutored six future NFL QBs at the college level, including first-round selections Patrick Mahomes (Chiefs), Baker Mayfield (Browns) and Johnny Manziel (Browns) as well as Case Keenum, Davis Webb and Nic Shimonek.

Under Kingsbury's guidance, Mahomes (2016) and Keenum (2009, '11) both led the nation in passing. Mahomes (2015-16) and Keenum (2008-08, '11) are two of the five quarterbacks (Lamar Jackson, Deshaun Watson, Graham Harrell) in FBS history to record 5,000+ yards of offense twice in a career. Keenum finished his college career by throwing for 5,631 yards and 48 TDs on 428-of-604 attempts in 2011.

During his lone season at Texas A&M (2012), Kingsbury mentored Johnny Manziel, who became the first freshman ever to win the Heisman Trophy after throwing for 3,706 yards and rushing for 21 TDs.

OTHER COACHING CAREER: Kingsbury began his coaching career at the University of Houston as the offensive quality control coach (2008-09) prior to being elevated to QBs coach (2010) and co-

offensive coordinator in 2011.

With Kingsbury serving as co-offensive coordinator in 2011 and calling the plays, Houston led the nation in total offense (599.1 ypg), passing offense (450.1 ypg) and scoring (49.3 ppg). Keenum was selected as the Sammy Baugh Award winner as the nation's top quarterback and finished seventh in Heisman Trophy voting.

Kingsbury spent the 2012 season at Texas A&M as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach. Texas A&M finished third nationally in total offense (558.5 ypg) with an attack that ranked 13th nationally in rushing (242.1 ypg) and 14th in passing (316.5 ypg). The Aggies beat #1 Alabama on the road and #11 Oklahoma in the Cotton Bowl.

In his only two seasons as an offensive coordinator (2011-Houston; 2012-Texas A&M), Kingsbury was named Offensive Coordinator of the Year both years by FootballScoop.com.

Following his tenure as head coach at Texas Tech, Kingsbury was hired as the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at USC prior to joining the Cardinals.

PLAYING CAREER: Kingsbury had a prolific career as a quarterback at Texas Tech (1999-2002), playing his last three seasons under Mike Leach where he set 39 school records, 16 Big 12 marks and 17 NCAA records during his collegiate career while throwing for 12,423 yards and 95 TDs. As a senior in 2002, he was awarded the Sammy Baugh Trophy as the nation's top college QB and was also named the Associated Press Big 12 Offensive Player of the Year while finishing 9th in Heisman Trophy voting.

At Texas Tech, Kingsbury recorded more than 12,000 passing yards and total offense, including over 1,000 completions, making him just the third player in NCAA history to accomplish all three feats.

He was drafted in the sixth round (201st overall) of the NFL Draft by New England in 2003 and spent his rookie season on the Patriots injured reserve list before spending the 2004 season on the Saints practice squad. Kingsbury played in one game with the

Jets in 2005 and completed one of two passes for 17 yards. He played with the Cologne Centurions of NFL Europe in 2006 before attending training camp with the Bills that summer. Kingsbury finished his playing career in the CFL by playing with the Montreal Alouettes and Winnipeg Blue Bombers in 2007.

PERSONAL: Kingsbury grew up and played high school football under his father, Tim, at New Braunfels (TX) High School where he threw for over 3,000 yards and 34 TDs as a senior in 1997 to lead the Unicorns to the Class 5A Division II state semifinals just one year after finishing 4-8. New Braunfels finished Kingsbury's senior season with a 13-2 record, which included six come from behind wins. In 2018, Kingsbury was inducted into the Texas High School Football Hall of Fame.

While at Texas Tech, Kingsbury was one of 14 collegiate football players to receive a post-graduate scholarship from the National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame. He was also awarded with Academic All-America Player of the Year honors in 2002, the highest academic honor for a player in Texas Tech history. Kingsbury earned a bachelor's degree in Management from Texas Tech in 2001.

- Minnesota has won the past 2 meetings, both at U.S. Bank Stadium, and hold a 17-11 all-time series advantage. The Cardinals have a 7-6 lead in games played in St. Louis and Arizona.
- The home team has won each of the past 7 meetings between the clubs.
- The Vikings last victory in Arizona was on 12/14/08, a 35-14 win, guided by QB Tarvaris Jackson's 4 TD passes and Adrian Peterson rushing for 165 yards. Jackson earned NFC Offensive Player of the Week for his performance.
- In a scheduling quirk, the two teams met twice in 1991, a home game for each, that the Vikings swept by a combined 62-7.

- The Cardinals franchise began in Chicago from 1920-59, spent 1960-87 in St. Louis and moved to Arizona in 1988.
- In 1983, the Vikings and Cardinals opened the preseason in the first-ever NFL game played in London on August 6 at Wembley Stadium, a 28-10 Vikings win.
- Xavier Rhodes notched the longest INT return in Vikings history, a 100-yard TD, against Arizona on 11/20/16, a day that also included Cordarrelle Patterson taking a Cardinals kickoff back 104 yards for a TD.

In Week 1 at Cincinnati, Cousins became the first Vikings QB to start four straight season openers since Daunte Culpepper (2002-05). Cousins' 73.5 completion percentage was a team record for a season opener with a minimum of 50 attempts. Cousins finished eighth in the NFL with a 105.0 passer rating in 2020 while setting the Vikings record for highest career passer rating with a minimum of 1,500 attempts. Since joining the team in 2018, Cousins has completed 1,157 of 1,675 attempts en route to a 103.3 passer rating. The veteran quarterback became the second player in team history to throw 35 or more touchdowns in a season and set a franchise record with eight games of three-plus passing touchdowns in 2020. His 17 career games with 300-plus passing yards, three-plus touchdowns and 115.0 or better passer rating are the most in the first nine seasons of a quarterback's career in NFL history.

Jefferson put together arguably the best season by a rookie receiver in the Super Bowl era in 2020, breaking an 18-year-old rookie receiving record as he finished the year with 1,400 yards en route to Pro Bowl and All-Pro honors. He became just the second player since the AFL-NFL merger to post seven 100-yard receiving games as a rookie, and his 87.5 receiving yards per game rank second-most by a rookie in the history of the league. The fifth receiver drafted in 2020, Jefferson set Vikings rookie records for receiving yards (1,400), receptions (88) and 100-yard games (7), passing the marks established by Hall of Famer Randy Moss during his 1998 Offensive Rookie of the Year campaign. Jefferson became the first Vikings WR to complete a pass in a single game since Sidney Rice vs. Oakland, 11/18/2007. He also became the first to attempt a pass since Stefon Diggs vs. Green Bay, 12/23/2019.

Cook, who signed an extension with the Vikings the day before the Week 1 matchup with Green Bay went on to post a career year in 2020, earning his second consecutive Pro Bowl selection. 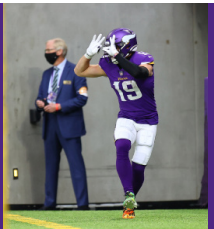

BE THE CHANGE

In June 2020, the Minnesota Vikings and the Wilf family announced a \$5 million donation to social justice causes throughout the United States. Following the announcement, the team's social justice committee held a series of meetings to determine how to actively engage the community through player involvement and financial donations during the 2020 season. **On September 8, the team announced nearly \$1 million will go toward the expansion or launch of multiple initiatives in one of three areas of focus: 1) voter education and registration; 2) educational curriculum on racism and Black history; and 3) law enforcement and criminal justice reform.**



VOTER EDUCATION AND REGISTRATION AWARENESS

Working together with the Office of the Secretary of State, the Vikings are using the team's platform to encourage fans to register and safely participate in the electoral process. The Vikings will launch a series of player-led voting content and make it easy for fans to find voting information via [Vikings.com/bethechange](https://vikings.com/bethechange). The team will also help provide personal protective equipment (PPE) for polling workers throughout Minnesota. Additionally, the team has hosted voter educational sessions with the entire Vikings staff and players/coaches in conjunction with Rock the Vote and Secretary of State Steve Simon with the goal of having 100% of the organization registered to vote in the November election.

ALL SQUARE

The Vikings will further expand the team's commitment to [All Square](#), a local nonprofit social enterprise that invests in the minds and lives of formerly incarcerated individuals. Centered on a craft grilled cheese restaurant, professional development institute, and forthcoming civil rights law firm, All Square's mission is to ensure that those impacted by the criminal justice system have the support and opportunities they deserve to become our country's future leaders, business owners, legal practitioners and entrepreneurs. The Vikings engagement will focus on All Square's Fellow & Fellow Alum Fund.

GEORGE FLOYD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In June, the Vikings created the George Floyd Legacy Scholarship with a \$125,000 endowment that will generate approximately \$5,000 annually to benefit African American graduating seniors in Minneapolis-St. Paul who are pursuing post-secondary education. The inaugural recipient, Mimi Kol-Balfour, was selected following her essay submission and was informed last week via videoconference by Vikings Owner/President Mark Wilf, General Manager Rick Spielman, running backs Alexander Mattison and Ameer Abdullah, and linebackers Anthony Barr and Eric Kendricks. Kol-Balfour is a graduate of Southwest High School who will be attending Barnard College this fall.

CRITICAL CONVERSATIONS

In partnership with [RISE \(Ross Initiative in Sports for Equality\)](#), the Vikings will host a series of Critical Conversation sessions with Minnesota High School athletic programs to help address issues of race and injustice. Vikings safety Anthony Harris and linebacker Anthony Barr spoke in August to a group of high school coaches to discuss the importance of having these conversations in a team environment. The program with RISE will further formalize the discussions and provide statewide access for Minnesota athletic programs to engage on these important issues.



306: BLACK HISTORY CURRICULUM EXPANSION

In 2016, with a focus on integrating Black history into mainstream U.S. history and developing courses devoted to the African American experience, the Vikings became the first NFL team to partner with Everfi in an effort to bring a [306 Black History](#) curriculum to Minnesota students. The interactive course informs and inspires today's students through history's most important stories of Black women and men who overcame obstacles through grit, strength, creativity and intellect. The digital curriculum incorporates videos from Vikings Legends, provides direct source materials and allows students to explore and reflect on key themes of Black history. Now in its fifth year, the program has since been replicated by the NFL in many markets. In 2020, the Vikings will expand the curriculum from 12 to 24 schools and reach thousands of students.

PROJECT SUCCESS

In 2019, the Vikings partnered with [Project Success](#), a Minneapolis-based organization focused on helping kids develop life-skills, support and confidence so they are more successful and engaged during high school and more prepared for life after graduation. The two organizations took 50 students of color from Minneapolis, along with Vikings running backs CJ Ham and Ameer Abdullah and safety Anthony Harris, to Washington, DC, for a special experience that included a visit to the National Museum of African American History & Culture. The trip was to be replicated in 2020, but due to COVID-19, this year's plan will be a day-long virtual experience and the Vikings and Project Success plan to return to DC in 2021.

VIKINGS SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE

The Minnesota Vikings Social Justice Committee consists loosely of 10 members and any player or coach is free to join the meetings. Co-Defensive Coordinator/Defensive Line Coach Andre Patterson has been part of the group, meeting regularly with Eric Kendricks, Anthony Barr, Alexander Mattison, Kirk Cousins, Kyle Rudolph, Ameer Abdullah, Adam Thielen, Anthony Harris and Harrison Smith on social justice initiatives.

Throughout the year, player-driven efforts strive to create meaningful dialogue and change in the community on issues related to building unity, hope and positive community relationships. The Vikings approach includes spending time with young people at schools, community organizations and juvenile detention centers and dedicating financial resources to organizations that work for positive change.

Over the previous two seasons, the Wilf family has made a \$500,000 commitment to the Social Justice Committee (\$250,000 each year). Those dollars were directed toward scholarships for low-income students, school supplies, legal aid for disadvantaged and underrepresented populations and law enforcement relations.

VIKINGS IN THE COMMUNITY



COVID-19 RELIEF

As part of the State of Minnesota's COVID-19 Community Vaccination Program, the state partnered with the Minnesota Vikings on two community vaccination events at Twin Cities Orthopedics (TCO) Performance Center in Eagan. More than 16,000 Johnson & Johnson doses were administered at TCO Performance Center to health care workers and adults 65 years of age or older. Additionally, the State of Minnesota hosted a temporary community vaccination event at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, in which 10,000 COVID-19 vaccines were administered.

JEFFERSON HOSTS BACKPACK EVENT

Vikings WR Justin Jefferson distributed 100 free backpacks filled with school supplies outside the Phyllis Wheatley Community Center ahead of the new school year for students.



VIKINGS PLAYERS SURPRISE YOUTH

Vikings LB Eric Kendricks, WR Justin Jefferson and DE Danielle Hunter surprised youth currently residing at People Serving People with a back-to-school event hosted by the Vikings and SCHEELS.

THIELEN FOUNDATION STADIUM LIGHTS

Adam Thielen and his wife, Caitlin, through the Thielen Foundation, have committed to replacing the stadium lights at Brooklyn Center High School (BCHS). The school's stadium lights were red-tagged several years ago due to safety concerns. Following the safety concerns, athletes have not been able to play games under the lights. The impact of re-igniting the stadium lights will create a lasting impact on the students, staff and Brooklyn Center community.

HURRICANE IDA RELIEF

Category four Hurricane Ida made landfall in the southeastern Louisiana coast on Sunday, August 29 and caused devastation in Louisiana and across the Gulf Coast. In efforts to help provide relief for those in need, several Vikings players, coaches and ownership came together to donate over \$100,000 to the American Red Cross and their disaster relief efforts.

KENDRICKS AND HIPPY FEET

Vikings LB Eric Kendricks, teamed up with Hippy Feet to create a line of products that help support homeless youth. Hippy Feet, a Minneapolis-based Benefit Corporation is dedicated to supporting the homeless, with each product sold helping provide transitional employment to young people, ages 16-24, who are experiencing homelessness. Since its launch in 2016, Hippy Feet has been able to provide jobs for more than 150 young people affected by homelessness.

RAISE THE BARR FASHION SHOW

Vikings LB Anthony Barr hosted a fashion show and football event for his foundation, Raise the Barr, to support single parents continuing their education. Since Anthony and his mother, Lori, co-founded Raise the Barr in 2016, the nonprofit has given more than \$410,000 in scholarships and emergency grants.



MINNESOTA VIKINGS RING OF HONOR

KEVIN WILLIAMS



The Ring of Honor recognizes Vikings legends for their contributions to the success of the team on and off the field. Members of the Ring of Honor forever live in Vikings lore. This year, Vikings' Legend Kevin Williams will be inducted into the Vikings Ring of Honor during the weekend of October 3, when the Vikings host the Cleveland Browns.

Williams was the #9 overall draft pick in 2003 and went on to earn All-Rookie honors and set the team rookie record with 3.0 sacks in a game at Arizona. He went on to start every game he played for the Vikings over his 11 seasons, 177 games including playoffs. Williams played in 2014 with Seattle and 2015 with New Orleans, starting in Super Bowl XLIX for Seattle. For his NFL career, Williams started 202 of his 212 games, including playoffs.

Williams earned Associated Press 1st-Team All-Pro honors in five seasons (2004, 2006-09), was named to the NFL's Team of the Decade for the 2000s and had six Pro Bowl berths (2004, 2006-10). Williams and John Randle are tied for 2nd in team history for Pro Bowl berths by DTs (6) behind only Alan Page's 9 honors.

Williams' 60.0 sacks as a Viking rank behind only Randle and Page among DTs and he is tied for the franchise record with four defensive touchdowns (2 INTs, 2 FRs). As a cornerstone of the Vikings defense, Williams led a unit that ranked #1 in NFL run defense in three consecutive seasons (2006-08), the first time a defense achieved the feat since the 1970 AFL-NFL merger.

The addition brings the Vikings Ring of Honor to 26 members. GAME NOTES

- This is the Vikings first opener on the road since 2016.
- The Vikings season opener record is 34-26-1 in 61 seasons. This was the first time the Vikings played the Bengals in a season opener. In season opener overtime records, the Vikings are 2-2.
- The 14-play, 91-yard touchdown drive for the Vikings is the longest Week 1 touchdown drive since 2017 against the Saints (98 yards.) This is the third 90+ yard touchdown drive in Week 1 dating back to 2001.
- Head Coach Mike Zimmer moves to 5-2-1 in overtime games, including playoffs.
- QB Kirk Cousins moves into a tie for the fourth-most starts by a Vikings QB with his 48th.
- Cousins is the first Vikings QB to start four straight season openers since Daunte Culpepper 2002-05.
- Cousins set a team record for career highest completion percentage (69.2), for season opener games with a minimum of 50 attempts.
- This is the third time Cousins has passed for 350 or more passing yards with two or more touchdowns and zero interceptions while with the Vikings.
- WR Justin Jefferson becomes the first Vikings WR to complete a pass in a single game since Sidney Rice vs. Oakland, 11/18/2007. He also becomes the first to attempt a pass since Stefon Diggs vs. Green Bay, 12/23/2019. His first career pass marks WR K.J. Osborn's first career reception.
- WR Adam Thielen recorded his 40th and 41st touchdown reception of his career.
- WR Thielen ties career-high two touchdown catches and has his second straight two-touchdown day in a season opener (2020 vs. Green Bay). The team record for receiving touchdowns in an opener is four by Ahmad Rashad vs. San Francisco in 1979.
- Thielen went over 400 catches in his career.
- Since 2020, Thielen is tied with Davante Adams for the most multi-touchdown games in the NFL with five.
- G Oluosameka Udoh became the first player from Elon to start a game since 1987. Last was RB Jimmy Smith with the Vikings on Oct. 4, 1987 against the Packers.
- NT Michael Pierce set a career high in sacks (2.0) and tied a career high in tackles for loss (2.0) and total tackles (7). His last full sack was the 2017 season opener at Cincinnati.
- LB Nick Vigil recorded two tackles for loss and a sack against the Bengals. Dating back to 2020, Vigil has recorded a sack in his last three-of-four games.
- Eric Kendrick's 15 tackles marks the second-most in his career - his most since Week 13 in 2018 when he had 16 tackles against the New England Patriots.
- Kendricks' 15 Week 1 total tackles are the most in a Week 1 game since Ed McDaniell in 2000 against the Bears.
- S Harrison Smith extends his team record for most sacks by a DB to 14.5. Joey Browner ranks second with 9.5.
- K Greg Joseph made a career-best 53-yard field goal attempt. Joseph is now tied for second-longest field goal in a season opener with the team.
