

STEP 1 RESEARCH YOUR DEALER

> Research each dealer's history, background and customer feedback. A good place to start is social media, online forums and Google reviews. Rather than relying solely on the dealer's own website you may find Google reviews to be more genuine, independent and uncensored.

> Choose one company for the total import process – purchase, importation, freight, compliance, registration and delivery. It is crucial to have one dealership responsible for vehicle quality and importation service.

STEP 2 KNOW YOUR TIMEFRAME

Discuss your time-frame needs with your dealer. If necessary, indicate the date you *must* have delivery of your vehicle. It takes 6 to 8 weeks on average to deliver and prepare a vehicle for sale AFTER it is purchased in Japan. Keep this timing in mind when chosing your delivery date.

STEP 3 KNOW YOUR BUDGET & INCLUSIONS

Specify your desired budget but also know your absolute maximum budget limit. Ask your dealer to be crystal clear on all inclusions. Does the price include registration, if so how long? Does the price include warranty, engineer certificate and 'Admin. Fee'? Is a spare key included? What about English language conversion?

Give your dealer a very detailed wish-list that includes year, mileage, color, fabric, desired options and must-have options. Don't forget to mention non-smoking condition or anything else you might feel particular about. Be prepared to compromise on the options as it may be impossible to find the exact match.

STEP 5 KNOW HOW TO READ AN EXPORT CERTIFICATE

Request the original Export Certificate ('Dereg. Paper') to be included in your car's paperwork. If you have no original – no deal. You need to know how to read the Certificate in order to confirm your car's mileage. Please contact us – we are happy to explain your Export Certificate in a private, one on one consultation by phone or Skype or come and visit us.

STEP 6 PAY SMART

Leave a deposit, which is FULLY refundable – just in case problems arise with the vehicle or time frame. Agree on a third party pre-purchase mechanical inspection. Make sure both parties sign a contract. Pay in full only after your vehicle arrives and independent inspection confirms it is roadworthy and presentable.
