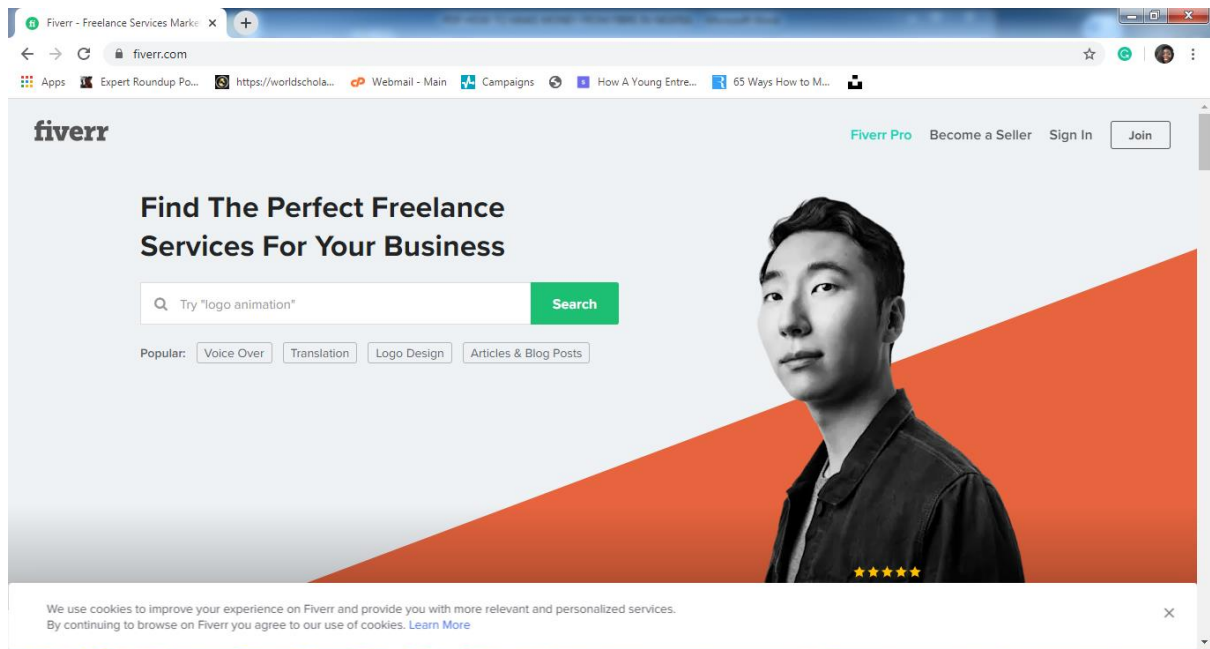


How to make money on Fiverr in Nigeria PDF

Now, I'll take you through the processes of earning on Fiverr one step after another.

Step #1 Visit Fiverr website



To start with, Log into to the Fiverr website www.fiverr.com .

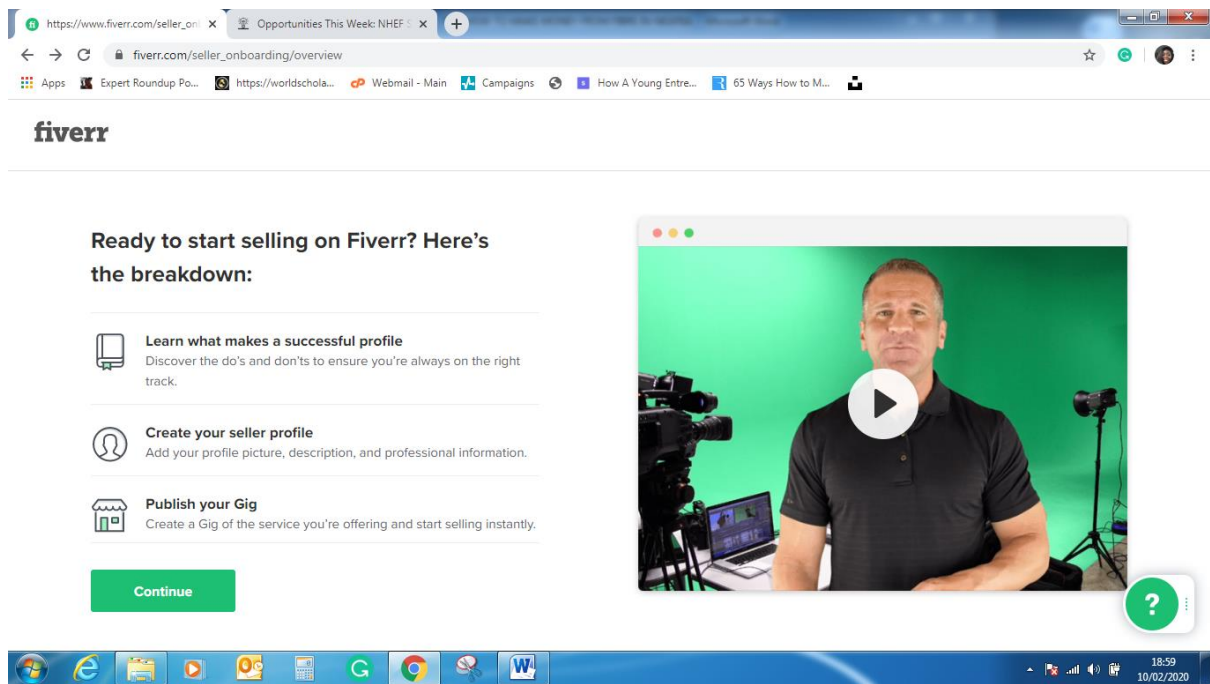
From the home page you'll see the columns: Fiverr Pro, Become a seller of Sign in.

You may click on either Become a seller or Sign in.

Once you click on either buttons, you'll be prompted to sign up with either your Google account or your Facebook account. You may sign up with either your Facebook account or your Google account and you'll be successfully signed in.

Step #2 Create your seller profile

Next, you'll start creating your seller profile once you are successfully logged in. Before you start creating a profile, Fiverr will run you through a breakdown of how to start selling on Fiverr and what makes a great profile as shown in the image below.

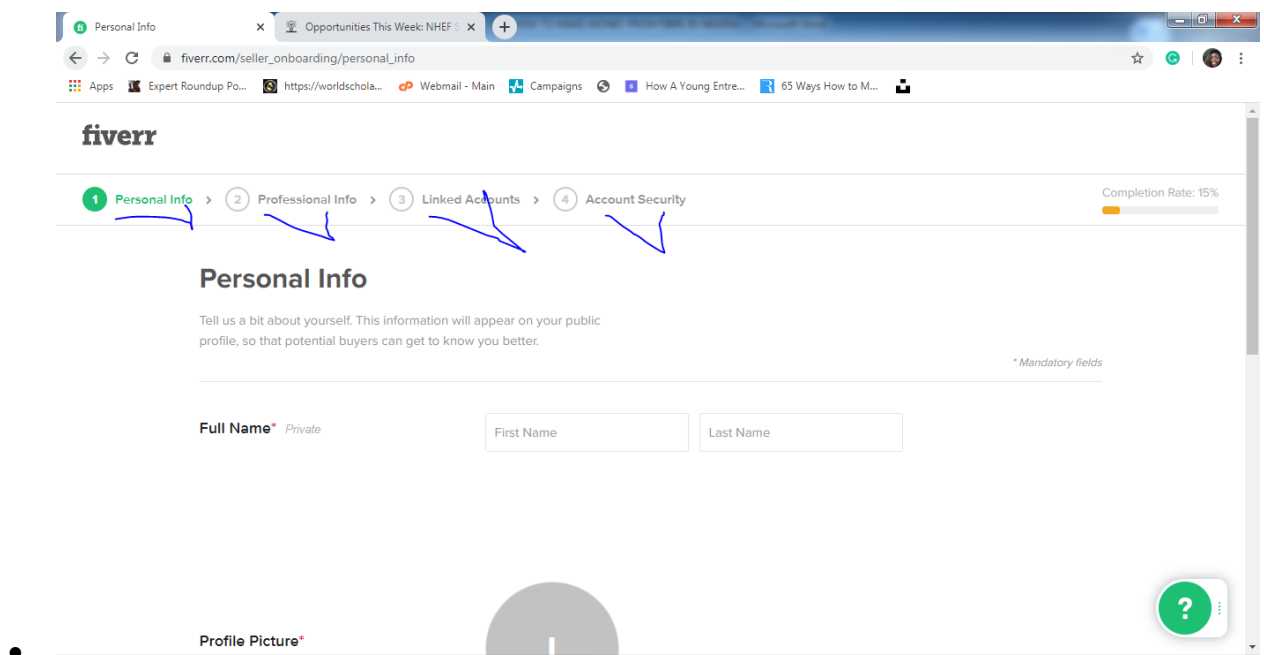


Make sure you read through carefully to start off with Fiverr best practices.

Once you've read through the breakdown, you should be knowledgeable enough to go ahead and create your mouth-watering seller profile.

Now, for your seller profile, there are four requirements every seller must meet. They are:


- Personal info
- Account security
- Professional info
- Linked accounts



The first sets of information to provide are your **personal information**. These include your full-name, your profile picture, your description (that is the skill you have) and your preferred language i.e. English.

Make sure you complete all the forms that Fiverr provides you with by filling in all the required details in their appropriate columns. Next, click on the continue button once you're done completing each of the forms.

In the process, an email would have been sent to your inbox. Login to your email and click on the link Fiverr provides you with to confirm and activate your Fiverr account.

Here are some Pro Tips to help you smoothly create a profile

Make sure that your profile delivers on each and every of the aspects below:

- **Profile Picture:** Upload a professional looking photo of your real face. This will help to ensure potential buyers trust that you're a real person and aid your profile professionalism.
- **Description:** Use this section to introduce yourself to potential buyers. Here, you can include your areas of expertise, experiences, or anything else you think is important. Remember to always submit relevant information.
- **Languages:** Let others know the languages you speak and your level of fluency in those languages; this is very important, especially if your gig includes skills like writing or translating.

- **Tests Taken:** This part of your profile will display the tests that you've completed through Fiverr. Tests help to verify your skills, and can increase a potential buyer's trust. Just be careful, as you're only able to take a test twice every three months; however, Fiverr does give you the option to hide your tests scores if you do poorly.
- **Skills:** This should include any skills applicable to the gigs (services you render) you intend to create. These may include abilities you've gained in the past jobs, hobbies, or other life experiences. Fiverr only allows ten, choose wisely.
- **Education:** Include where you attended school i.e. higher education and your degrees.
- **Certifications:** Here, you are expected to list any additional certifications that may help you stand out from the crowd.

Please don't be daunted by this steps highlighted above; they are not as complicated as they may seem at all. In fact, it's something you can single-handedly complete without any guard if you read the instructions on the website carefully.

Once you've created a profile, it's time to create your gigs and start working.

STEP #2 Create and publish a gig

You need to create a gig before you can start earning with your Fiverr account. Once you've created a seller profile, you must create a gig to begin selling your skills and making money with your account.

A gig simply means the freelance service you'll be rendering on Fiverr i.e Animation, SEO, content writing, Digital marketing, etc. Gigs on Fiverr are priced at \$5.00 and upwards.

Fiverr has up to 8 categories of services that you can provide via their platform.

So, you'll have to choose your own gig or the category of services you would want to render which are:

1. Graphics & Design
2. Digital Marketing
3. Writing & Translation
4. Video & Animation
5. Music & Audio
6. Programing & Tech
7. Business
8. Fun & Lifestyle

To create your first gig, go to the "Selling" menu along the top of the screen, and in the drop-down menu choose the "Gigs" option. From here, you simply need to click the "Create New Gig" button to start the process.

Step #3 Write Your Gig Overview

The first section you'll need to complete is the Gig Overview. Here, you'll be required to fill out three boxes:

The title of your gig

The category that it falls under

Relevant search tags

So this is how to go about creating your gig:

Your gig title is very important. However, they should be very basic as to the service you are offering.

The "I will" is already done for you, you just have to start from the third word onwards.

For example, you will just start typing "create a website for you" (no need for period or punctuations as they are not allowed) and you'll see just below that box if your title is good enough or not.

Next, select the category you had picked earlier when choosing what service to offer. You should also select any sub-category and options that Fiverr gives you as you select things.

Search tags are important; they are words that will help people find your gig. Use all five provided if possible.

Once this is all complete, click on the green "Save & Continue" button.

STEP #4 Pricing

This step 4 is very crucial to how you can start making money on Fiverr in Nigeria.

If you're just starting out, I sincerely suggest you start with a basic package of \$5. You can increase this as you get better ranked within Fiverr and when you start getting many orders.

\$5 dollars is not bad at all to start with. If you are very good at what you do, you will definitely get more requests and with that, you can charge more amount and get gigs more frequently too.

In time, you could be making as much as \$30 daily which is more than N300k monthly.

You can offer more services with the Standard and Premium packages which you can charge more for.

Next, fill in all slots that are available and applicable to you. The more info you can offer up front, the better the gig.

Once you have the three packages filled out, you can press the “Save & Continue” button again to move on to the next tab.

Gig extras is a great way to get more money from your buyers like a faster service. You can easily add \$5 for doing something quicker.

Step #5: Description & FAQ

At this point, you are almost done, well-done so far. Keep following through.

If you want to really make reasonable money with your fiverr account as a Nigerian, haven't gone through this PDF guide, the description here is equally very important. It explains what each package will entail. So, be precise, detailed, and clear about what you are offering so that it will be clear to buyers.

There's a minimum amount of 120 characters that you'll have to write here and a maximum amount of 1,200 characters allowed.

So use this space wisely and make sure you use it to your full advantage to explain the services you're offering in each package to your potential buyers.

Remember, you can look at other gigs similar to your service to see what and how they do it for example sake. There is no crime in that learning from others.

You will not need to fill out the FAQ, however, it's easy for your potential buyer to just get a few quick questions answered just by looking at this section.

Most of the FAQ may include:

- What is required of the buyer?
- How long will it take for the gig to complete?
- If it's a writing gig, how many words is required of you?
- What's expected of you as the seller? Etc.

Step #6: Requirements

The requirements of the gig are things you'll need from your buyer(s) as soon as they make order for your gig. The thing is, without these requirements, you won't be able to start your work.

And the time starts counting as soon as you receive the order so it doesn't matter when you receive an order either while you are still on the bed, catching some sleep, your order starts right there when it hits your account.

Therefore, when you wake up to your new order, you would want these requirements already available to you so that you can quickly get to your work as your order is timed based on what you put in the Pricing tab.

Please ensure you enter in everything you'll need from your buyer to limit the amount of time it usually will take to communicate with them back and forth as to what you need.

Once your requirements are completely put in, click "Save & Continue".

Step 7: Your Visuals

Congratulations for coming this far. We are there in a bit!

Giving a good look for your gallery is also important to your making money on Fiverr.

This is a visual of your portfolio and you have several formats you can use to feature your work: video, photos and PDFs.

If you use images, you're only allowed three and the best dimensions to use are **550 px by 370 px**. Most Fiverr sellers usually use the Primary photo as their "banner" for their gig and will include their gig title in the image.

Try to use all spaces available for whatever format you choose to showcase your work. You can use more than one format also.

Click "Save & Continue" once gallery is completed.

Now to the most exciting part.

Step #8: Publish

Here's the most exciting step, publishing your very first gig!!

Because it's your first gig, you need to verify by phone first. So when you are ready with your phone, click on "Verify Now" and follow the steps to get verified. It's quite easy.

Once you are verified, you are published!

Congratulations on publishing your first ever gig!

If you put in lots of effort and improve on your skill, you can start earning an equivalent of a full-time job earning using Fiverr.
