Courses

HUM 350: Life and Culture Abroad

This course is an introduction to Guatemalan history and culture. Through a combination of reading as well as direct observation and experience, we will strive to understand the place, the time, and the people that we encounter in Guatemala. There are, of course, numerous questions we can ask. What do we share? How do we differ? How has history shaped the current state of Guatemalan culture? How is the current state of technological advancement affecting the people we encounter? What does it mean to be a human being in world of human beings? How are we ultimately to read and understand our world? [GE C.3 & Z] (3 units)

ENGL 306: Guatemala: The World in Words

This course will focus on creative non-fiction. We will write about the things we experience in Guatemala that will include traveling, culture, working with a small non-profit aid organization, people, and, well, nearly anything and everything that we encounter. In the end, the narratives we produce will be our own, told in our own voices, crafted over time as we prepare, travel, and return.
