NEW YEAR-ROUND UPDATE PROCESS FOR PARENTS TO UPDATE FAMILY INFORMATION ONLINE:

- 1. Parent/Guardian will log into the PowerSchool Parent Portal.
- 2. Once in the portal, choose the appropriate student (changes will need to be done for each child listed in the account).
- Select InfoSnap Year Round Update on the left side under navigation. (This will take a couple seconds to populate the information that is currently in PowerSchool.)
- 4. Once the student information is populated, the parent/guardian is free to change the appropriate information such as primary mailing name, contact #, address, mother/father/guardian information, and emergency contact information.



<u>Wisconsin Forward Exam - Upcoming for 3rd and 4th Grade Students</u>: the Wisconsin Forward Exam - our state test - will be taken by 3rd and 4th grade students in April. Here are the dates and a bit more information to help your child be successful with the assessment:

Schedule:

3rd Grade (English Language Arts and Math)

- Tuesday April 11, Wednesday April 12, Thursday April 13
- All tests will begin at 8:50 am

4th Grade (English Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science)

- Tuesday April 4, Wednesday April 5, Thursday April 6, Friday April 7 and Monday April 10
- All tests will begin at 8:50 am

A few reminders:

- Please make sure that your child is in school on the testing dates
- Make sure that your child gets a good night's sleep and eats a healthy breakfast before testing days.
- Send an additional snack on test days.
- MAKE SURE THAT YOUR CHILD PLUGS IN HIS/HER IPAD AND THAT IT IS CHARGED AT 100%. All testing will occur on the iPads.
- Make sure that your child has headphones or earbuds. These are required for the test.

Thanks for your help! Our students have traditionally scored very well on our state assessments, thus allowing us to achieve National Blue Ribbon Award status. The support of our families in helping to make our students successful is incredibly important and appreciated!
