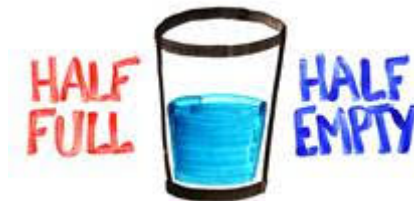

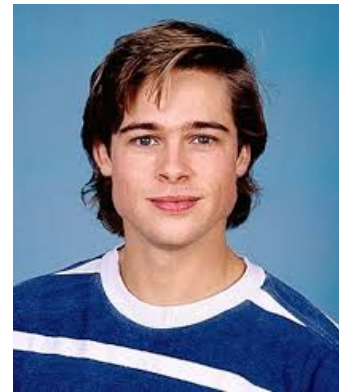
Is the Legacy Campaign's glass half full or half empty?

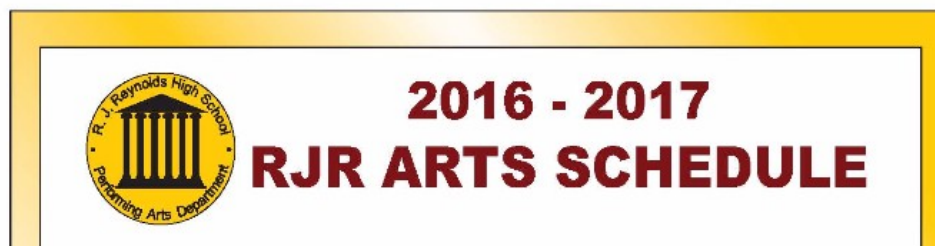
