







 There is one <u>exception</u> and that is <u>martyrdom</u>. But this is <u>not</u> for all believers.








B. The language of the OT attributes everything under the final, absolute authority and command of <u>God</u>.


Hebrews 4:13

And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but <u>all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him</u> to whom we must give account.























- C. He has set laws and principles of <u>life</u> on this earth.
 - God's Word is <u>law</u> and He Himself will abide by it. Psalm 89:34
 - 2. These laws and principles of life apply to <u>all</u> men believers and unbelievers.

E. God intervenes based on His Word and when His people **prays** accordingly.



- II. In God's <u>Sovereignty</u>, He gave man a <u>free</u> will and complete <u>ownership</u> of the <u>earth</u> realm.
 - A. It is within God's Sovereignty to give man a free will.



A. It is within God's Sovereignty to give man a free will.

Genesis 1:26

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them <u>have dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, <u>over all the earth</u> and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."



B. It is within God's Sovereignty to give man complete <u>ownership</u> and <u>responsibility</u> over the earth realm.

Genesis 1:28

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the <u>earth</u> and <u>subdue it</u>; <u>have dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the <u>earth</u>."



B. It is within God's Sovereignty to give man complete <u>ownership</u> and <u>responsibility</u> over the earth realm.

The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's; but the <u>earth</u> He has <u>given</u> to the children of <u>men</u>.

You have made him to have <u>dominion</u> over the works of Your hands; You have put <u>all things under his feet</u>

D. God's Sovereignty does not violate our free will.


E. His foreknowledge does <u>not</u> nullify the exercising of our will nor negate our choices - Psalm 139



The fallenness of $\underline{\text{man}}$ and works of the $\underline{\text{evil ones}}$ results in:


 Fracture of the physical <u>earth</u> and corruption of the <u>environment</u>.



 - A. This suffering affects **<u>both</u>** the believer and the pre-believer in this fallen world.

John 16:33


These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."




- "Good" things may happen to "bad" people.

- 2. I may not fully understand my suffering but <u>God</u> does.






D. Rather say "God is Sovereign".


This means:


- I seem to lose control when bad things happen to me but my <u>God</u> knows, He is in-charge as I commit my situation to Him.
- 4. The question **"Why did this happen"**? should follow with the question "is <u>God</u> with me in this situation"?













F. At the individual level, man will <u>reap</u> what he sows according to the respective laws of life in:

James 5:19-20

19Brethren, if anyone among you <u>wanders from</u> <u>the truth</u>, and someone turns him back, **20**let him know that he who turns a sinner from the <u>error of his way</u> <u>will save a soul from death</u> and <u>cover a multitude</u> <u>of sins</u>.



F. At the individual level, man will <u>reap</u> what he sows according to the respective laws of life in:

1 John 5:16-17

16If anyone sees his brother sinning a <u>sin which</u> <u>does not lead to death</u>, he will ask, and He will <u>give him</u> <u>life for those who commit sin not leading to death</u>. There is <u>sin leading to death</u>. I do not say that he should pray about that. 17All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.



F. At the individual level, man will <u>reap</u> what he sows according to the respective laws of life in:

Ecclesiastes 7:17 Do not be overly wicked, nor be foolish:


Why should you <u>die before your time</u>?



G. In these last days, there will be an <u>increase</u> of earthquakes, wars, famines and pestilences and lawlessness according to the scriptures.


This is due to the deteriorating $\underline{\textbf{corruption}}$ of man and the earth.

Matthew 24:8 (NIV) All these are the beginning of <u>birth-pangs</u>.

 - B. The demonic world can influence and control to the extent of the <u>ground</u> given [doorway, foothold].



according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of <u>disobedience</u>.



C. In the case of the <u>believer</u>, the Grace of God comes to him as he <u>prays</u>.

God does <u>not</u> unilaterally, randomly, or haphazardly intervene in the affairs on earth unless His people **prays**.



- C. In the case of the <u>believer</u>, the Grace of God comes to him as he <u>prays</u>.
 - 1. Our <u>prayers</u> lay the tracks on which the train of God's Grace runs.
 - 2. Our prayers are earthly license for <u>heavenly</u> intervention.
 - 3. Our prayer is the altar we build to <u>connect</u> earth to heaven.



- C. In the case of the <u>believer</u>, the Grace of God comes to him as he <u>prays</u>.
 - 4. Our prayers "**create**" the <u>ladder</u> on which God commands the angels to descend and ascend to minister to us.
 - 5. If we don't pray, the spiritual world cannot <u>connect</u> with the natural world.





D. For the believer who perseveres to trust in God, the outcome can be <u>positive</u> while he is <u>on</u> this earth which is

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

Genesis 50:20a - But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good ...



E. The exception is persecution and martyrdom.

Hebrews 11:35b-40

35 ... Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. **36**Still others had trial of mockings and scourgings, yes, and of chains and imprisonment. **37**They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented—



E. The exception is persecution and martyrdom.

Hebrews 11:35b-40

38of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, *in* dens and caves of the earth.39And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, 40God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.



VI. God is good and is **<u>consistently</u>** good all the time.

Psalm 34:8

Oh, <u>taste</u> and <u>see</u> that the LORD is good; <u>blessed</u> is the <u>man</u> who <u>trusts in Him</u>!

VI. God is good and is **consistently** good all the time.


Exodus 34:6-7a

6And <u>the LORD passed</u> before him and <u>proclaimed</u>, "The LORD, the LORD God, <u>merciful</u> and <u>gracious</u>, <u>longsuffering</u>, [slow to anger] and <u>abounding in</u> <u>goodness</u> and <u>truth</u>, 7<u>keeping mercy</u> for thousands, <u>forgiving</u> iniquity and transgression and sin ...



Jeremiah 32:38-41

38They shall be My people, and I will be their God; **39**then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, <u>for the good of them</u> and their children after them. **40**And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away <u>from doing them good</u>; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me. **41**Yes, I will rejoice over them <u>to do them good</u>, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul.'
