Dear Parents/Guardians: We are in a different time. This is our 26th year to provide free art, music, environmental classes to youth 8-18. Class size is <u>extremely</u> limited since we are conforming to the 6-foot social distancing rules.

A light pre-packaged snack and drink will be provided mid-morning.
