Dear Parents/Guardians: We are in a different time. This is our 26th year to provide free art, music, environmental classes to youth 8-18. Class size is extremely limited since we are conforming to the 6-foot social distancing rules.

All students and teachers are required to wear masks. Our classes are filled on a first come basis. We are asking everyone to look at what is being offered and to submit the schedule. Please fill out the Parent Agreement form. You must fill out the COVID-19 form for your child to attend the Art House. When your child is registered you will receive a postcard telling you you're your child/children have been accepted.

Please keep this card because it will remind you of our starting date and the weeks that your children will attend.

If for any reason your child(ren) cannot attend, please contact us immediately so that we can admit another child to the program. We will not have Hooked on Books or Lunch. Our program does not provide breakfast, transportation, early morning-late afternoon care. Students will have to have their breakfast at home before they come for the 10:00 class.

A light pre-packaged snack and drink will be provided mid-morning.

Arrival--Please arrive at 9:45 to 10:00 to door 4

Dismissal--At 12:00 and 3:00 Door 5

All walkers and riders will be picked up and the end of the building—Door 5

Please note that the summer program runs Monday through Friday; new classes are offered *each week*. This is different than our after-school program which runs day by day.
