# PROMOTION STANDARDS 2017-2018

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In order for HISD students to move to the next grade level, they must show that they have met HISD's Board Approved Promotion Standards. These standards

generally include classroom grades, local or state tests, and attendance as follows:

1. State requirement of overall yearly average of 70 or above and local requirement of an average of 70 or above in reading, other language arts, mathematics, and science or social studies
2. **Sufficient attendance** – a student's total number of unexcused absences cannot exceed 10 percent of class meetings

# ATTENDANCE

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- Students who have accumulated **more than 10% of unexcused absences, meaning 16 or more days not in school**, will be denied credit in these courses based on the **current HISD attendance policy** unless the attendance committee grants credit because the absences are due to extenuating circumstances.
- **The School Attendance Committee** has responsibility for reviewing absences of students who have excessive absences in excess according to the HISD Attendance Policy.
- Students with unexcused absences between 10%-25% of class meetings can have credit restored upon successful completion of a plan approved by the principal.
- **The School Attendance Committee shall be appointed by the principal. The majority of the committee must be comprised of classroom teachers.**

## Promotion Standards/GPC/IGC


### Passing a Summer School Course Does Not Guarantee Promotion

A student whose revised overall average is still less than 70 at the end of Summer School might not be promoted, even though the student may have passed the course or courses taken in Summer School.

<b>Total:</b>	313	→	343
<b>Average:</b>	63	→	69

- **8:00-2:30**

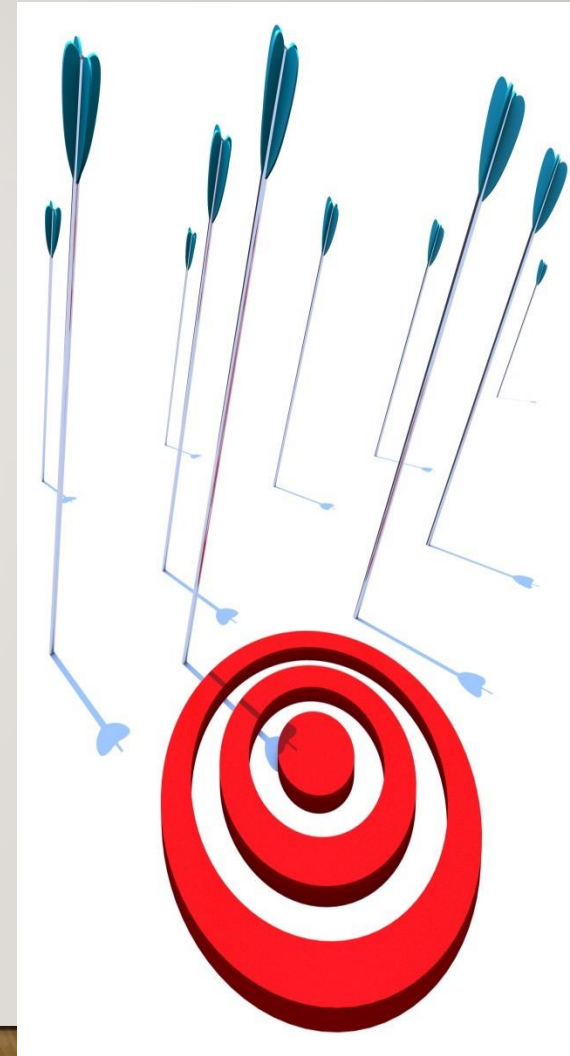




# WHY ARE STUDENTS HERE?

□ Students are here because of one or more reasons:

- They did not pass their **Core Classes**
- They did not have a cumulative average of **70 or above**.
- They exceeded the number of absences allowed **16 or more days**



# IN ORDER FOR **STUDENTS** TO BE SUCCESSFUL....

- They **must pass** all their summer school classes.
- They **must attend** the mandated number of days.



# DRESS CODE

□ Dress Code for **students** will be the same as it is during the school year:

- **6<sup>th</sup> grade** will wear **Navy Patrick Henry T-shirts**.
- **7<sup>th</sup> grade** will wear **Red Patrick Henry T-shirts**.
- **8<sup>th</sup> grade** will wear **Blue Patrick Henry T-shirts**.
- All students wear khaki pants or Jeans for summer school along with school Approved T\_SHIRT

- **FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE DRESS CODE WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING:**

- **STUDENTS WILL BE ASKED TO CALL HOME TO HAVE SOMEONE BRING THEM THE REQUIRED UNIFORM.**
- **IF A UNIFORM CAN NOT BE BROUGHT, STUDENTS WILL SERVE (1 day OF LUNCH DETENTION)**
- **REMEMBER, ALL TIME OUT OF CLASS WILL ADD UP AND MAY KEEP THEM FROM MOVING ON TO THE NEXT GRADE.**



# DISCIPLINE/ATTENDANCE STUDENT NON-NEGOTIABLES

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- Discipline and Attendance goes hand in hand during summer school.
- Students are only allowed two absences
- Anything more than two absence will result in immediate Retention in current grade level.
- If students are sent home due to disciplinary issues this counts as a absence.
- So once again there is a **No Tolerance Policy** for disciplinary behaviors!!!!





# DISCIPLINE/ATTENDANCE STUDENT NON-NEGOTIABLES

- THERE IS A **NO TOLERANCE** POLICY FOR STUDENT MISBEHAVIORS
- THIS **MUST BE STRICTLY ENFORCED** AND FOLLOWED
- **ANY STUDENT MISBEHAVIORS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE**
- **“STUDENT CONSEQUENCES”**
- 1<sup>ST</sup> Offense students will be sent to office and placed on contract
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense will result in immediate disciplinary consequences
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense will result in immediate expulsion from summer school and retention in current grade level
