SACRAMENTS

Marriage: When you become engaged, call the Parish Office to make an appointment with a priest. The period of preparation requires a minimum of six months. Weddings are celebrated on Fridays at 4PM or on Saturdays at 11AM or 2PM.

A NOTE FROM FR. JONAS

"When the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor the disciples were there, they themselves get into boats and came to Capernaum looking for Jesus. And when they found him across the sea, they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" Jesus answered them and said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw a sign but because you ate the loaves and were filled." (*today's gospel: Jn. 6:24-35*) Jesus knew why they were looking for him, they got a free meal, but they did not understand that what Jesus had done and the feeding was a sign- a sign that would have a message for them. Jesus told them: "Do not labor for food that perishes."

A sign always points to something else. An exit sign tells us how to leave a building or a parking lot. Smoke tells us there is fire somewhere. A no smoking sign tells us not to smoke. Jesus wanted to tell people that the miracle of the loaves pointed to something more. But they didn't see that. They didn't not know it was a sign. They were content

with having their stomachs filled. That's why he said, "You are not looking for me because you have seen signs but because you have eaten your fill of loaves." They wanted only what they wanted, not what Jesus wanted to give them. Here he is telling that he is giving the bread of life and he is the bread of life.

In our relationship with God, we must ask ourselves, are we interested only in getting God to give us what we want, or are we willing to work so that God can give us what God wants for us. Jesus said, "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you." Jesus said: "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent." We should be aware of this whenever we encounter our Lord in the signs of bread and wine. "Lord, you give us the strength of new life by the gift of the Eucharist. Protect us with your love and prepare us for eternal redemption." ~Fr. Jonas

MISSION CO-OP COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

Each year, as part of the Mission Cooperative Program, the Diocese assigns a certain religious group to speak in the Allentown Diocese parishes. Because of international travel restrictions they are unable to send a speaker this year. **However, we do still have a scheduled collection for this group on August 8th.**

This year's collection is for nursing training in Uganda. Fr. Joseph from Uganda states, "In Uganda we have an acute need for nurses. Today the patient ratio stands at 8:1,000. In July of 2019 in my home Diocese of Hoima, Uganda, we started a nursing school named St. Ambrose School of Nursing and Midwifery. The school opened with 160 students both boys and girls. This year we have 260 students. I have been doing fundraising to buy a school bus to help in transporting the students to hospitals where they go to practice what they have learned in class. The also go to communities and villages to sensitize people about home hygiene and sanitation. This is all part of their training. At the moment they do these trips on foot, 12 miles one way, every day. This is very cumbersome and harder for the handicapped students. At the moment we need to raise \$52,900 on top of what we already have. God bless everyone who will donate to this noble cause".

For many, many years we have provided a Mass for the residents at Gracedale every 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month. After Mass Extra Ordinary Ministers visit the rooms of the Catholic patients who cannot attend Mass to bring them Communion. Good news, we can now return to Gracedale. At this time, they are COVID free and the residents miss us.

They do have a protocol in place: -We must check in at the desk when we arrive, -Everyone has to be vaccinated and we have to show proof of that, --We will have to complete a form, -Our temperature will be taken, -We must wear a mask, -If there are any Residents with Covid or with symptoms, those floors are closed to all visitors and volunteers.

We will not be resuming Mass till September 11th or 25th. We will not be distributing Communion on the floors until we all get reoriented and are comfortable doing so. **We still need your help!** Because most residents at the Mass receive Communion in the mouth, we have to sanitize our hands before continuing onto the next resident. We will need EM's to give Communion and to assist with the sanitizer.
