Angels of Hope



“To you, O Lord, we lift up our souls.”
 Your ways, O Lord, make known to me;
 Teach me your paths,
 Guide me in your truth and teach me,
 For you are God my savior,
 And for you I wait all the day. (Psalm 25:4-5)

As we enter this new season of Advent, we do so hearing the sound advice of Psalm 25. After getting through this past year, which began in November 2020, where there has been so much rage and anger both in our society and in our church, we need to hear what the psalm suggests we do – with open hearts we ask God to teach us His paths and to guide us in His truth. What better advice can we possibly imagine as we stand on the threshold of a new church year.

Saint Paul prays, in his letter to the Thessalonian Community,

that the “Lord may make them increase and abound in love for one another and for all...” (1 Thess 3:12) He wishes this for them that they might be blameless in holiness before God when the Lord comes with all his holy ones. His hope for the community is that they might be prepared when the Lord comes the second time.

The blessed season of Advent assists us in asking ourselves what we must do to be prepared for the sacred time to come. Advent is not only about celebrating Christmas and all it means for us but about what is yet to be when the Lord comes again. Are our hearts prepared that we might be blameless before God? Are we prepared to hear and embrace what God is trying to teach us along His path of truth? The prophet Jeremiah, St. Paul and Jesus all want us to be ready for what God has in store for us. Advent is the time to take the necessary steps, let’s not waste it!

RACIAL JUSTICE REFLECTIONS: EMMANUEL, GOD WITH US

Black Catholic Theologian M Shawn Copeland shared her perspective of #BlackLivesMatter as “public theology” in her recent address to the 31st Annual Meeting of the Black Catholic Theological Symposium. Copeland sees a “humanly diverse public” brought together through BLM, “imagining and forming a new public space for speaking and listening, for conversation and interchange, for healing and creative human actions.” Through “fierce compassionate solidarity,” she says, BLM invites each individual to see one another as human beings, as “icons of the Divine Transcendent One,” as human persons made in the image and likeness of God.

As we begin this Advent season welcoming Emmanuel, God With Us, pause to reflect. Where do you envision God alive in our world today? Can you see God’s face in *all* people? What images of our neighbors *challenge* you to recognize the image and likeness of God? Whose voice do you hear speaking the prophet’s vision, “I will make My dwelling among you ...I will walk among you and be your God” (Lev 26:11-12)? We pray with this weekend’s Scriptures: “Your ways, O LORD, make known to me; teach me your paths, Guide me in your truth.” (Ps 25:4-5) “May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, just as we have for you, so as to strengthen your hearts.” (1 Thes 3:12) Share your response at racialjustice@hawb.org.

EDUCATION AND ACTIVITY CORNER

Sunday Family Connection: In today’s Gospel, Jesus warns his disciples against the fatigue that can emerge if one becomes consumed by the anxieties of daily life. Many families are too familiar with the kind of fatigue Jesus refers to here. We may be concerned about a family member’s health, our job security, our children’s education, or any number of other concerns. All these are important matters. Jesus does not promise an end to daily worries and fears, but he does teach his disciples that they will have the strength to withstand anxiety if they stay focused on him, remaining vigilant for his return and praying for strength to endure all tribulations. Through prayer, God helps us stay focused on that which is most important in our lives.

As you gather as a family, recall the tradition of making New Year’s resolutions in preparation for the new calendar year. Observe that today is the first Sunday of Advent, which is the beginning of the new Church year. During the season of Advent, our Gospel readings ask us to consider what is most important to us as we prepare for Jesus’ coming, at his birth and at the end of time. Read today’s Gospel, Luke 21:25-28,34-36. Jesus describes signs that may disturb many people, but he says that these should not to disturb his disciples. Why? (because these signs indicate that redemption is near) What does Jesus say that his disciples should do? (Be vigilant and pray for strength.) At this start of the new Church year, consider as a family what “Advent resolutions” your family might make to help you stay focused so that you will be prepared to receive the salvation we celebrate at Jesus’ birth and anticipate at Jesus’ second coming. Pray together for God’s help in following through on these resolutions. Pray together today’s psalm, Psalm 25.

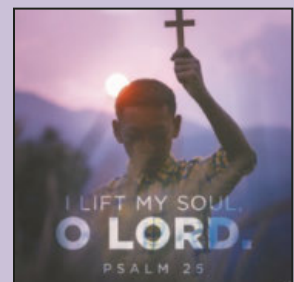

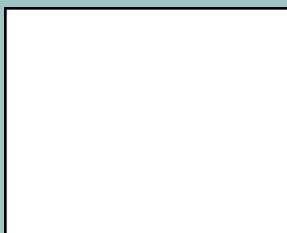

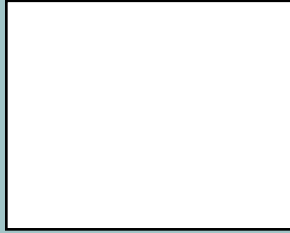
