They were willing to keep our website on their servers until our contract ran out. Of course, I didn't rush to find a new webhosting company; after all our contract didn't expire until August 2016!! The months flew by and suddenly I was under a deadline!! I found that there were a lot of webhosting companies out there!! After reading reviews and doing research I settled on Weebly, a webhosting company based in San Francisco. 

There are just 4 basic requirements:

- 4. A loop for hanging
