
Socratic Style

Criteria in Player Development





Standardized and Socialistic

- Coach Education-- grassroots delivered to club
 -- A, B, C three weeks long
- Structure-- DFB, to DFL, to BDFL (30,000 clubs)
- Policy/Procedure-- Standard and centralized DFBNET
- Finance-- Federal funding evenly distributed
- Culture— Aktion Ehrenamt, DFB sponsored training

PLAN—COMMUNICATE—COORDINATE—CONTROL
