Crape myrtle 'Hopi' (<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>)	Sun	7' x 6'	pink (July-Sept.)	Compact type, may die to roots in winter
Crape myrtle 'Natchez,' 'Sarah's Favorite' (<i>L. indica</i>)	Sun	18' x 12'	white (July-Sept.)	Fast-growers; nice peeling bark; red/orange in fall
Crape myrtle Pink Velour® (<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>)	Sun	15' x 8'	magenta (July-Sept.)	Glossy burgundy foliage; resists mildew
Crape myrtle 'Tonto' (<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>)	Sun	8' x 7'	rose (July-Sept.)	Maroon fall foliage; may die back to roots in winter
Crape myrtle Rhapsody in Pink® (<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>)	Sun	10' x 6'	pink (July-Sept.)	Purplish young foliage; resists mildew; sterile; no brown pods

Dogwood Aurora® (<i>Cornus</i> x 'Rutban')	Shade/part shade	18' x 18'	white (April)	Bug/disease-resistant hybrid; no fruits
Dogwood 'Cherokee Chief,' 'Cherokee Brave' (<i>Cornus florida</i>)	Shade/part shade	20' x 20'	pink (April)	Mildew-resistant; maroon fall foliage; red fall fruits; Pa. native
Dogwood Stellar Pink® (<i>Cornus</i> x 'Rutgan')	Shade/part shade	20' x 18'	pink (April)	Bug/disease-resistant hybrid; no fruits
Flowering cherry 'Kwanzan' (<i>Prunus serrulata</i>)	Sun	30' x 30'	pink (April)	Double flowers, gorgeous in bloom
Flowering cherry 'Okame' (<i>Prunus x incam</i> 'Okame')	Sun	25' x 20'	pink (April)	Very early bloomer; coral fall foliage
Flowering cherry 'Yoshino' (<i>Prunus x yedoensis</i>)	Sun	35' x 30'	white (April)	Arching branches; planted at D.C.'s Tidal Basin
Flowering cherry 'Akebono' (<i>Prunus x yedoensis</i>)	Sun	40' x 30'	pink (April)	Pinker than 'Yoshino;' longer-lived than most cherries
Full-moon maple 'Aconitifolium' (<i>Acer japonicum</i>)	Part shade	25' x 30'	burgundy (April)	Cut leaves turn crimson in fall
Ginkgo 'Autumn Gold' (<i>Ginkgo biloba</i>)	Sun	50' x 30'	none	Fan-shaped foliage; bright-gold fall color
Ginkgo 'Princeton Sentry' or Golden Colonnade™ (<i>G. biloba</i>)	Sun	50' x 20'	none	Fan-shaped foliage; durable; narrower than species
Hawthorn 'Winter King' (<i>Crataegus viridis</i>)	Sun	20' x 25'	white (May)	Showy winter red fruits; has some thorns; plant in spring

Japanese tree lilac 'Summer Snow' (<i>Syringa reticulata</i>)	Sun	20' x 15'	white (June)	More compact than 'Ivory Silk'; durable street tree
Katsura tree (<i>Cercidiphyllum japonicum</i>)	Sun/part shade	50' x 25'	none	Heart-shaped leaves; also smaller weeping form

Redbud Flame Thrower® (<i>Cercis canadensis</i>)	Sun/part shade	18'-20' x 15'	pink (April)	Showy, multi-colored burgundy/red/yellow leaves; Pa. native
Red buckeye (<i>Aesculus pavia</i>)	Part shade	18' x 16'	red (May)	Showy in bloom; seeds poisonous; U.S. native
Red oak (<i>Quercus rubra</i>)	Sun	60' x 50'	none	Fast-grower; red fall leaves; subject to wilt disease; Pa. native
River birch Dura Heat® (<i>Betula nigra</i> 'BNMTF')	Sun/part shade	40' x 25'	catkins (spring)	Peeling light tan bark; multiple trunks; Pa. native
