

Sustainability Merit Badge

- 1. Scouts can complete all requirements during October.
- 2. Scouts will participate in two virtual (Zoom) group meetings, one all together at the beginning of the month (Oct 5) and one in small groups at the end.
 - a. First group mtg for all scouts Monday, October 5, 7:30-9:00pm: complete requirements #1; #2 COMMUNITY A, ENERGY A; and #3; and discuss how to complete all other requirements.
 - b. Second meeting in small groups (6 max) to complete all other requirements. Three options: Oct 27, 28 or 29, 7:00-9:00pm
- 3. Before the first meeting, scouts must complete the work for requirements #1; #2 COMMUNITY A, ENERGY A; and #3 and be prepared to share notes and sketches of their work, ideally in an online file (i.e. PowerPoint, Word). Scouts must also review all requirements and be prepared to participate actively in group discussion.
- 4. Maximum number of scouts: 18.

- 1. Scouts will complete requirements 1 and 2 through group discussions during October.
- 2. Scouts will complete requirements 3-6 after completing independent projects/research and follow-up discussion with the counselor. Some of this can be completed in October, but most likely will be past October.
- 3. Scouts will participate in two virtual (Zoom) group meetings, plus individual telephone conversations:
 - a. Group session to review requirements, and discuss requirements 1 and 2, and to discuss how to complete requirements 5, and 6.
 - Group session to discuss requirement 3 projects/activities and requirement 4 outdoor study.
 - c. Individual discussion with each Scout for requirements 3-6.
- 4. Sessions: October 4th 4:00-5:00pm and October 11th 4:00-5:00pm
- 5. Before the first session, Scouts must have reviewed all of the requirements and be prepared to discuss requirements 1 and 2 as a group.

- 1. Scouts will complete requirements 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7 during October
- 2. Scouts will complete requirement 3 after October by sending an email to Mr. Case with their three-month chore log.
- 3. Scouts will participate in two virtual (Zoom) group meetings, plus individual telephone conversations on three topics:
 - a. Group meeting to complete requirements 1, 2, and 7, and to discuss how to complete requirements 4, 5, and 6.
 - b. Group meeting to review and approve each Scout's proposal for completing requirements 4 and 5 (projects).
 - c. Individual discussion of each Scout's project for requirement 4.
 - d. Individual discussion of each Scout's project for requirement 5.
 - e. Individual discussion of each Scout's family meeting for requirement 6.
- 4. There will be two opportunities: one on Sunday afternoons, one on Tuesday evenings.

- 1. Requirements 4b, 4c, 4d, 4e, 4f, 5a, 5b, 5c will be completed across the computer screen.
- 2. Requirements 1, 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b, 3c, 4a, 5d, and 6a require Scouts to complete work outside of the virtual sessions:
 - a. 1, 2a, and 2b will be completed by Scouts reading/researching and responding by e-mail.
 - b. 3a, 3b, and 3c require Scouts to teach chess to someone who does not know how to play.
 - c. 4a requires demonstration of chess notation, completed simultaneously with 5d and 6a.
 - d. 5d requires solving five chess problems and sending by e-mail the answers in chess notation.
 - e. 6a requires playing three games against an opponent, recording all moves in chess notation, e-mailing the three games, and receiving my review/analysis of the games.
- 3. The group will meet four times:
 - a. Tuesday, October 6 7-9:30pm to cover Chess Basics
 - b. Tuesday, October 13 7-9:30pm to cover Chess Tactics
 - c. Tuesday, October 20 7-9:30pm to cover Chess Strategy
 - d. Tuesday, October 27 7-9:30pm to cover Chess Opening and Endgame Play
- 4. No prerequisites. Scouts should obtain and read the merit badge booklet, but they need not do so before the first group session.
- 5. Note: virtual sessions involve lots of screen sharing, as chess games and move sequences are played out on chess engines available on the internet.
- 6. Maximum number of Scouts: 15

- 1. Scouts will complete all requirements.
- 2. Four 1-hour meetings:
 - a. Friday, October 2 7:30-8:30pm
 - b. Friday, October 9 7:30-8:30pm
 - c. Friday, October 16 7:30-8:30pm
 - d. Friday, October 23 7:30-8:30pm
- 3. Before the first meeting, Scouts (with a parent's permission) should use the internet to find a blog, podcast, website, or an article on the use or conservation of energy. Scouts should be prepared to deliver a <2-minute speech on the main points of the article, blog post or podcast during the meeting.
- 4. Before the third meeting, Scouts will need to purchase and build a solar kit of some kind; the most common solar kit is a solar car which can easily be found for <\$5.00.
- 5. Scouts will need to conduct an energy audit of their home <u>and</u> keep a 14-day energy log outside of group meeting time
- 6. Maximum number of Scouts: 12

- 3. Scouts will participate in two virtual (Zoom) group meetings:
