





Guarda is not only one of the Engadin's prettiest villages, but also the home of the little mountain boy Schellen-Ursli, the great Swiss picture-book hero. A two-day excursion takes you into his world – and reveals a particularly authentic slice of Switzerland.

Schellen-Ursli is alive. He has a long white beard, a weather-beaten face and a mischievous look. The friendly 73-year-old goes by the name of Not Schlegel. As a boy, he was the little hero who inspired the pen of children's author Selina Chönz. Aged 10, he played the role himself in the first Schellen-Ursli film, which now gathers dust somewhere in the Hollywood archives and was never shown in Switzerland.

His family received 200 Swiss francs for it, the equivalent of two month's salary for a humble worker in the picturesque Engadin village of Guarda, where Not still lives today. The son of a farmer, he has never ventured into the big wide world, not even on holiday. "I'm on holiday here every day," he laughs. "Guarda is the most beautiful place on earth."



That's also what he tells the little visitors who he whisks through the Schellen-Ursli Experience every week. It's a part of the family package with the same name: a two-day adventure in the footsteps of Switzerland's most famous picture-book hero (Heidi excepted), which includes a two-night stay in a family hotel and many extras.

During the high season, Not takes the children to the museum first, where he kits them out in traditional shirts, hats and neckerchiefs – Schellen-Ursli style. Then he leads the colourful group through the village, stopping at the Schellen-Ursli House, the bellsmith and the goat barn.

Not Schlegel gets a helping hand from his 83-year-old hunting colleague Jachen Andri Caviezel. Together they are the Schellen-Ursli dream duo – there is no question about the book, its history and the village Guarda they can't answer.

While the kids are entertained, parents can take time out for spa treatments in one of the partner hotels, or find their own fantasy world on a sunny panoramic terrace, from which the enchanting landscapes of the Lower Engadin unfold – the reality is every bit as captivating as how author Selina Chönz portrayed it in her 1945 book Schellen-Ursli.
