From Our Pastor



It is with a sense of sadness that we will soon bid farewell to our beloved **FR. PEREZ**, who has so faithfully served his home parish of SEAS for the past six years. But our sadness is tempered by knowing that he will soon be leading a "flock of his own". Father Perez will become the new pastor at Our Lady of the Valley Church in Luray, Virginia. The new clergy transfers will take place on Wednesday, June 26th. **Father's last Sunday Mass with us will be at 12:30 pm on June 23rd. We will be having a reception to honor Father immediately after in Seton Hall.** Please stop by and express your gratitude to Father and assure him, and those entrusted to his care, of our continued prayers.

Later this month we will welcome **FR. DORT BIGG**, a very gifted and prayerful young priest. Fr. Bigg attended DeMatha High School in Hyattsville, Maryland and later moved to Alexandria where his home parish is the Basilica of St. Mary. After high school and aspiring to become a professional violinist, Father entered The Julliard School of Music in New York but later felt a strong calling to the priesthood. He entered Mount St. Mary's Seminary in 2007. Father served as a transitional deacon at Blessed Sacrament Church in Alexandria and upon ordination to the priesthood, he was assigned to St. Louis Parish where he has served these past four years. More information is forthcoming on a welcome reception for Fr. Bigg to be held soon after his arrival.

This Monday, June 3rd we welcome **ROBERT RENNER**, one of our **diocesan seminarians** as he **begins his parish summer assignment here at SEAS**. Robert just completed his First Theology year at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland. He grew up in Holy Spirit Parish in Annandale and studied geography at the University of Mary Washington. Please join me in welcoming Robert and keeping him, and all of our seminarians and women in religious formation, in our continued prayers.

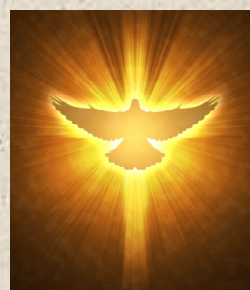
Finally, after much prayer and discussion I am pleased to announce that, beginning September 1st, 2019 we will be **adding a 6:30pm Sunday Evening Mass every weekend**. For these reasons, and to alleviate any confusion with our new 6:30pm Sunday evening Mass, beginning August 31st **our Saturday Vigil Mass will be moved from 6:00pm to 5:00pm**. Saturday Confession time will remain the same, 3:30pm-4:30pm.

Weekly Reflection:

Listen to the Spirit's "Come"

The upper room (Acts 1:3), where Mary and the apostles stayed while they waited for the Holy Spirit, exists in each of us. Deep within us we all carry a pure longing, expectation, and openness to the Spirit. In this room, only one word is said: Come! The Spirit says: Come! And the bride responds: Come! The Spirit entices the bride and the bride entices the Spirit in this ongoing "Come!" they whisper to one another. God comes to us and we come to God. If both are "coming," the encounter is inevitable. Our prayer can't be a monologue where we are hearing nothing but ourselves repeating: "Come, Holy Spirit!" We must also listen to the Spirit's "Come!" His "come" is much sweeter, much more penetrating than ours. We must let ourselves be enticed and fascinated by his "come"; we must let ourselves be caught in his net. We can say our "come" in a way that clearly shows the inadequacy of our faith. We can say it so forced and impatiently that it is obvious that we really don't believe that he will come. Our strained prayer is a sign that we have forgotten that he in fact has already come. We are asking for something we received a long time ago, but which we never quite recognized. "Come!" says the Spirit, "discover me!" Ever since our baptism, the Spirit has run through us as living water. The spring will never run dry. But have we forgotten to drink from it?

“Full Plates” Collection to Benefit Venezuela’s Gustavito Garcia Luján Center

There will be a special collection after all Masses, next weekend June 8/9, to benefit the Gustavito Garcia Luján (GGL) center, located in El Hatillo in an area called “Corralito,” a small town close to Caracas, Venezuela. The school is operated by the Salesians and serves 400 children, from elementary through high school, and 100 children in the daycare center.



The Venezuelan people are currently confronting the most horrific crisis in their nation’s history. It is a humanitarian crisis which is especially dangerous for the most vulnerable people, the children. GGL is making a significant effort to provide one complete meal and one snack daily to the students. Since the crisis escalated, the prices of food are increasing by the day and the Venezuelan people are suffering immensely. Families are making considerable efforts to send their children to GGL, where they feel safe and have the only meal they can have during the day.

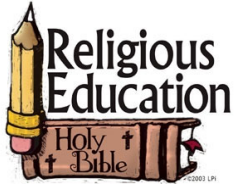

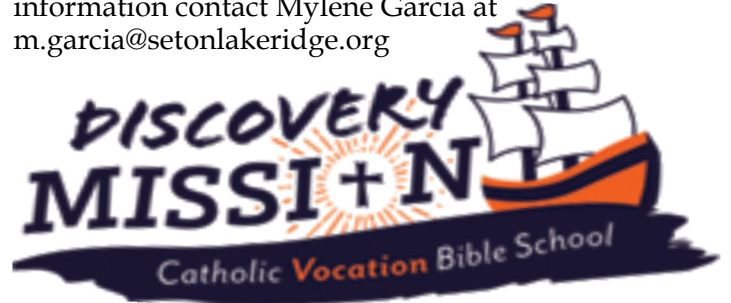

PENTECOST VIGIL MASS—SATURDAY, JUNE 8TH AT 6:00PM

Longing for the Holy Spirit to come and “bring to perfection his work in the world” ? Then come to the Extended Vigil Mass for Pentecost

Pentecost, the 8th Sunday of Easter, has long been seen as the day that completes the Easter event with the promised sending of the Holy Spirit. This year our parish is excited to celebrate Pentecost with an extended vigil, a liturgical tradition with deep roots and current value. The extended Vigil Mass is different than those of Pentecost day or even the simpler form of the Vigil Mass as the prayers, extra readings, and psalms are all meant to illustrate and increase a longing for the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Like Mary and the Apostles we too can gather in prayer awaiting the Father and His risen Son to send the Holy Spirit upon us! Join us on this 50th day of Easter and pray along with Mary, the Apostles, and all the Saints “Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.” (Psalm 104:30)

Human Concerns

ALWAYS COLLECTING.... Did you know? We have four small collection bins under the brochure rack outside the Parish Office door. Following is a guideline for what we do and do not collect.

From Left to Right ...

Bin #1: Hotel Toiletries

DO leave your unopened hotel soap, shampoo, conditioner, body lotion, etc.

DO NOT leave full size or opened products, makeup, perfume or powder.

Bin #2: Used Cell Phone and Eye Glasses

DO leave old cell phone and eye glasses.

Bin #3: Calendars, Coke Codes, and Postage Stamps

DO leave current year calendars, codes from Coke products, and First Class U.S. **CANCELLED** postage stamps **ONLY**.

DO NOT leave foreign stamps, stamps other than First Class, new uncanceled stamps, or stickers.



Bin #4: Religious Articles

DO leave **CATHOLIC** religious items such as: Rosaries, small statues, holy medals on chains, keychains, bookmarks, holy cards with images, small prayer booklets.

DO NOT leave Bibles, books, Psalms, broken or tarnished items, Mass cards, Christmas or All Occasion cards, or other stationery.
