



Port of Tacoma security officers are required to check credentials before entering TWIC restricted areas. Be prepared to present your TWIC card and load documentation upon arrival. Security officers also enforce parking and traffic regulations in the Tacoma Harbor. Port Security is located at Fabulich Center, 3600 Port of Tacoma Rd., Ste 106, Tacoma, WA. Call 253-383-9472 to report any suspicious activity.

The speed limit is 10 mph on all Tacoma harbor facilities unless otherwise posted.

TWIC Requirements

A Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) is required for all Port employees, terminal operators, longshore workers, truckers and others who require regular, unescorted access to Northwest Seaport Alliance restricted areas (i.e. marine terminals) and vessels. To access restricted Port-operated facilities, non-TWIC holders must be accompanied by a person who has been issued a TWIC and trained as an escort. Leased NWSA terminals have their own access guidelines.

MARSEC Security Levels

MARSEC security levels reflect the prevailing terrorist threat environment to the marine transportation system, including ports, vessels, facilities and other critical marine infrastructure. When entering a Port restricted area, you will see a sign that identifies the current MARSEC level. At any time, one of three different MARSEC levels is in effect (I, II, or III). Higher levels may result in delays.

MARSEC I – The level for which minimum appropriate security measures shall be maintained always.

MARSEC II – Appropriate protective security measures shall be maintained for a period due to a heightened risk of a transportation security incident.

MARSEC III – Further protective security measures shall be maintained for a limited period when a transportation security incident is probable, imminent, or has occurred, although it may not be possible to identify the specific target.

U.S. Customs

U.S. Customs officials may inspect your container load, either manually or using the most current technology. The vehicle-mounted VACIS and Radiation Portal Monitors (RPMs) are non-intrusive inspection technology that scans containers to identify items such as explosives, drugs or weapons of mass destruction. The scans help ensure that your load is legal and safe for transport.

Pick-Up and Drop-Off Information

The information listed below is needed for delivery or pick-up of cargo. Multi-company haulers must state the name of the company they are hauling for. Confirm container availability and/or whether vessel is open for receiving prior to arrival. Appointments and pre-arrivals at international container terminals are scheduled via eModal. Reference individual terminals for transactions requiring eModal activity.

Required for ALL Transactions

- TWIC card (a list of approved TWIC escorts is available upon request)
- Valid driver's license
- Truck license number and state of registration
- Truck company name, SCAC code
- Truck/tractor weight (lbs.)
- Trailer/chassis/flatbed weight in pounds. Include the weight of Genset if it is your own.
- Clean Truck registration (RFID tag)
- PPE (safety vest)

Additional information may be required depending on transaction

Container

Import Cargo Pick Up

- Master/BL number
- Container number
- PIN number (Husky, PCT-normally last 5 of BL)

Export Cargo Drop-off

- Booking number
- Seal number
- Commodity, temp settings (for reefer cargo)
- Check if vessel is open for receiving pre-arrival to terminal

Empty Pick-up

- Booking or release number
- Shipping line

Breakbulk & Non-Container

Pick-Up of Import Cargo

- Delivery Order containing:
 - BL/vessel/voyage numbers
 - Piece count, description, marks (specific per truck load; packing list may be required)
 - Destination, broker information
- T&E bond (Only for loads that are on a USCBP (Custom's) T.E. bond, the bond must be cancelled at USCBP office on the US side of the border before going into Canada.)
- Steamship Line release
- USCBP releases
- Authorization for truck loading charges

Drop-Off of Export Cargo

- Dock Receipt containing:

Note: When port employees load breakbulk/project cargo onto trucks, the work is done at the direction of the truck driver.

- Equipment Type (20'/40'/40' HC/45' reefer)
- Commodity, temp settings (for reefer cargo)

Empty drop off

- Container free of cargo, trash and placards

Chassis

- Match the correct chassis for the move: TPNP, DCLI or SSCO
- Bare TPNP chassis require a booking number. Go to www.tracconnect.com and click EZbook in top right corner

- Booking number/vessel/voyage
- Piece count, description, marks (cargo must be marked, marks match dock receipt or packing list, and be specific per truck load)
- Destination, broker information
- Steamship Line release
- T&E bond (Only for loads on a USCBP (Custom's) T.E. bond, the bond must be cancelled at USCBP office in Tacoma after cargo is delivered.)
- Customs validated documents (for used autos/self-propelled units, done at USCBP office after delivery)
- Authorization for receiving charges



Trucking Information

Keeping the Trucking Community Informed

We work to keep truck drivers and dispatchers informed of upcoming construction work, terminal holiday schedules and other issues that may impact access to our terminals.

Clean Truck Program

The Northwest Seaport Alliance Clean Truck Program requires all drayage trucks entering NWSA international container terminals in both the Seattle and Tacoma Harbors to have an RFID tag and a 2007 (or newer) engine, or a certified equivalent emission control system. The Clean Truck Program requirements reduce diesel particulate matter emissions by up to 90 percent per truck.

Your RFID tag must be registered with your current truck and driver information at www.emodal.com. While RFID tags are required on all compliant trucks, individual terminals may use green stickers when gates are experiencing downtime.

Heavy Haul Industrial Corridor (HHIC)

The Heavy Haul Industrial Corridor in the Tacoma Harbor allows qualified loads more than the legal weight limit to be legally transported between intermodal facilities and marine terminals.

Use of the HHIC requires a special permit from local and/or state agencies depending on the route.

For heavy haul permits to operate on **City of Tacoma** streets within the Port Industrial Area, contact the City of Tacoma Commercial Vehicle Division, **253-591-5479**. For more info, visit cityoftacoma.org/hhic

Note: Trucks hauling overweight cargo in the Seattle Harbor require a separate permit from the City of Seattle Dept. of Transportation-Traffic

Weight restrictions are in effect for several city and state-maintained streets and bridges leading into and out of the Tacoma Harbor.
