




Useful Tips for Sports Day

Registration for Sports Day is done prior to event day so make sure you arrive early in the event of any changes. While some churches have been participating in sports day for a number of years, others may be attending for the first time. Below are a few ideas of things that may be useful for you to think about as you plan your trip to Joseph C. Carter Park.

<u>Alcoholic Beverages/Cigarettes/</u> <u>Drugs/Firearms/Fireworks</u>:

None of these items are permitted on the grounds. Any athlete that is found in violation of any or all of the above will be dismissed from the games immediately

Cleanliness:

These are your grounds. If you see paper laying on the grounds, kindly pick it up and place it in a trash container.

Dress Code:

Recognizing that Christians should be modest in their dress, we would like to encourage all athlete to wear clothing that is in line with the standards of the game and our church.

You will need to bring appropriate clothing and footwear for events entered, and any appropriate equipment e.g., track-shorts, proper fitting shirts, towel etc.

First Aid:

A registered nurse is on the grounds at all times for emergencies, and a physician is on call. Please refer all accidents to the Medical Tent.

Lost and Found:

Please bring all articles found to the office. The office staff will try to assist in locating the owner of the item(s).

EATING ARRANGEMENTS:

You are strongly advised NOT to bring any packed lunch and refreshments with you, only water is allowed. Meals can be purchased at the concession stand and snack bar at a reasonable rate. This will help to offset the cost of our sports day.

Parking:

Your cooperation is needed in parking your car in the areas designated for parking. Please cooperate with the parking attendants.

Selling on Grounds:

Private vendors are not allowed to sell items on the campground without documented authorization from the Event Management Personnel or from the Office of Secretariat.

<u>WEATHER</u>: We are always hopeful for a warm sunny day and would, therefore, advise you to bring sun-block and a hat to put on, and plenty of water to drink. Last year was very hot so please bring plenty of water. On the other hand we cannot guarantee the good weather and it may be wise to pack something waterproof in the event of rain.

Remember that the weather could be different from what you wake up to. Seating for the day is only permitted on the stands, so you may want to think about bringing a blanket, umbrella or small tent.

Sports Day Notes for Participants

AY Leaders/Coaches meeting takes place by 8:00am so make sure you arrive early. Your team leader should report under the designated Tent upon arrival. Please read the notes on each event before you complete the registration form as this will give you important information about numbers of competitors in each event and the rules of each event. etc.

POINT-SCORING SYSTEM

In the athletics medals are given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place competitors (apart from the open mile), competitors in 1st – 8th place do earn points towards their church's overall ranking in the results table. The higher up the competition you finish will determine how many points your church receives. Once the points for individual events have been totaled, points are awarded to churches depending on what position they finished in each event.

The overall winner will be the church with the most points gained across all the events. Church placements will be post on our website following the competition – www.sofloadventistsports.org

GENERAL

One event rule: Due to the nature of sports day and the events running simultaneously, competitors may only take part in one event. For example, if you are part of the field team. you cannot also represent your church in athletics. The only exception to this is the 4x400m and the open mile, which anyone attending sports day can enter on the day. Changes sheets: All changes/withdrawals of competitors/teams should be notified to the admin team at Registration to enable them to update competitor lists. It is important that you fill the changes sheets in correctly so that we can provide coordinators of events with up-to-date lists of competitors to enable them to keep the competition on schedule. 'No shows': Following on from the previous point, increasingly there is a great deal of time-wasting when competitors do not show up, or are late for their event.

The Sports Day organizers, therefore, reserve the right to penalize any team who do not notify team changes correctly and/or persistently waste time by failing to arrive promptly for their event. This may mean competitors will lose the chance to take part in their event and they could lose points for their team in the overall competition. This has been a particular problem in the Athletics competition.

Date for reckoning ages: In order to decide which age range a competitor can compete in, their age should be reckoned as at 31st May. Leader for each event: We are asking that one person from your group is designated as the 'leader' for each event your group is competing in. For instance if you have soccer competitors entered, you must give us the name of the person (this can be a competitor in the event) who should be available to officials throughout the competition. All gueries to officials should be directed through this spokesperson. Wristbands: All spectators and competitors will be expected to wear their colored wrist bands throughout the day as a means of identifying you as part of Sports Day.

These will be sent out to you after the 18th May along with details of the scheduling for the day.

Help wanted: Anyone who can help with the running of any of the events on the day, please contact the office ASAP. We need a huge number of volunteers to help the day run smoothly, so anyone with experience of sports would be appreciated (e.g. timekeepers, starters, finishers, photographer, etc.). Fun Stuff: There will be a number of activities going on for spectators and competitors — e.g. half-time parade for everyone, basketball, volleyball, soccer and the kids play area to enjoy.



Rules & Regulations

The church with the most accumulated points at the end of the day will be declared SoFlo Champion of the year!!

(i) Each church can enter a MAXI-MUM of 2 competitors in each individual event, and a squad of 4-6 in the relays. In the threelegged race a maximum of 2 pairs can be entered.

Each competitor may enter a maximum of four events throughout the event. This must be two tracks and one field event and one relay. (For example: A competitor can enter the 100m and 200m and a choice of either High Jump OR Long Jump or Compete in a relay race) 4x100m RELAY: This event can only be entered on the registration form prior to the event, and not on the day itself. Only one squad per church is allowed in this event. 4x400m RELAY: 4x400m relay teams can be entered on the day, and you can enter more than one team per church. Listen for the announcement from the Registration Tent around 1pm to register your 4x400m relay team(s). Team members involved in another sport during the day must make this event a priority should the 4x400m heats or finals clash with another event. THE MILE: Anyone can enter the mile on the day. Listen for the PA announcement and report to the athletics track.

- LONG JUMP: No part of your body is allowed to touch the ground between the take-off line and the sand. You must take off from within the lane. You must not walk back through the sand after the jump. The jump is measured from the nearest break in the landing area made by any part of your body.
- (vii) HIGH JUMP: You must take off from one foot. You must not touch the ground or landing area beyond the uprights without first clearing the bar. If the bar falls off before you leave the mat this constitutes a failure. You are eliminated after three consecutive failures.

- (viii) POINTS SYSTEM: 1st Place 10 points, 2nd place 8 points, 3rd place 6 points, 4th place 5 points, 5th place 4 points, 6th place 3 points, 7th place 2 points and 8th place 1 point.
- 1. Unsportsmanlike conduct will disqualify a participant from the meet in progress and from advancing to the next level of competition, i.e., disrespect, profanity, throwing a baton, etc.
- 2. A runner must stay in the lane assigned for the 50 meter, 100 meter, 200 meter, and 400 meter dashes and the 4 x 100 meter relay.
- 3. It is the participant's responsibility to report to the bullpen area for an event on time. Participant must listen for the announcement of his/her event.
- 4. The following shall require disqualification of a participant from the event: competing in the wrong age group; wearing illegal shoes; aiding a participant directly or indirectly by accompanying participant to the starting area. running alongside participant, or being stationed at points along the track to aid / coach participant; exceeding the allowed event limit; causing a second false start; receiving a second warning at starting line for actions that confuse/upset other competitors; gaining an advantage by stepping on or over an inside line on a curve; stepping on or a lane line for three or more con-
- secutive steps with one or both feet on a curve; or causing interference of another runner.

The following shall require disqualification of a participant from meet in progress and advancing to the next level of competition: unsportsmanlike conduct and participating in more than the allotted events.

- . Lane and position may be drawn randomly or seeded according to guidelines adopted by the SoFlo event Organizers.
- 6. In the relay event, the baton must be passed within the exchange zone. No aid may be used on the track. The baton must be handed, not thrown. The runner passing the baton should remain in the lane so as not to interfere with a runner in another lane. Rules relative to fouling, coaching, or impeding a runner apply to relays.
- 7. A regulation baton must be used. It may not be wrapped with tape.
- 8. A participant may be excused from a field event to participate in a running event. The individual should return directly to the field event following the running event.
- 9. No spikes or shoes designated for spikes will be allowed on the track. In field events, any shoes designed for turf surface sports (natural or artificial) are not allowed. The participant's shoes cannot be used to gain an advantage. No athlete will be allowed to compete in bare feet.
- Jewelry, hair beads and decoration, sunglasses (except prescription) shall not be allowed during competition.
- 11. Selection to the Conference Team is not automatic by winning first place at the meet. Each territory is represented by two (2) participants per event. All 100 meter, 200 meter, and the 4 x 100 meter relay winners will qualify for the Conference Final Meet with the exception of 5-16 age groups.

Keep up the good work.




