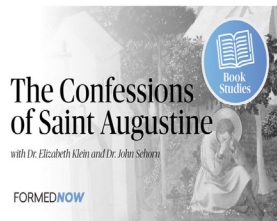
WITH GOD IN RUSSIA

THE CONFESSIONS OF ST. AUGUSTINE, SIX-PART SERIES

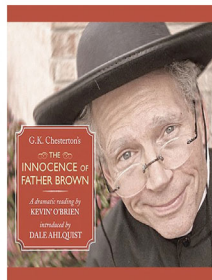
