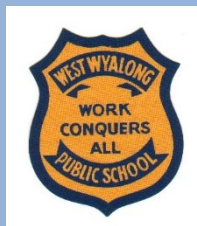

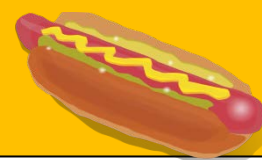

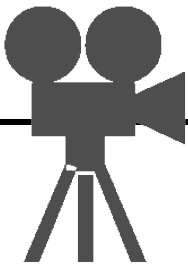

Friday- **Recorder Ensemble**- aimed at Year 2-6.

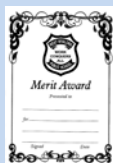
