Agenda item #2 Approval of the minutes of the September 16, 2010, Commission meeting at Austin, Texas

Commissioner Pennington asked that the minutes of the Work Session and the Quarterly Meeting be corrected to show his title as that of Senior Police Officer.

Commissioner Lovejoy made a motion to accept the minutes of the September 16, 2010, work session with the correction as requested by Commissioner Pennington. Commissioner Oakley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Lovejoy made a motion to accept the minutes of the September 16, 2010, quarterly meeting with the correction as requested by Commissioner Pennington. Commissioner Griffith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #3 Presiding Officer's Report

There were no items to report.

Agenda item #4 Executive Director's Report, if not read at the Work Session

This agenda item was covered during the work session.

Agenda item #5 Presentation on Peace Officer Memorial (Patt Scheckel-Hollingsworth)

Commissioner Hollingsworth addressed the commissioners and the audience by giving a brief history of the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial, reading the intent for creating the memorial, and explaining the need for repairs. TCLEOSE has a legislative mandate for the upkeep of the memorial. At this time, a golf tournament is being planned for a fund-raising event. Commissioners are being asked to make corporate contacts for donations. Commissioner Hollingsworth had prepared a slide presentation which included pictures of the condition of the memorial and photos of some of the officers listed on the memorial. At the conclusion of the slide presentation, Commissioner Hollingsworth asked that donations be sent to TCLEOSE to be forwarded to the Texas Preservation Board for use in repairing and maintaining the memorial.

Agenda item #6 - Take action to enroll officers in the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial

Jason Ball read the names of those being enrolled. After the reading, Commissioner Hollingsworth made a motion to accept the names for enrollment on the memorial. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #7 Take action to waive the requirement for induction at a separate Commission meeting, and take action to induct officers into the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial who were enrolled today.

Commissioner Hollingsworth made a motion to waive the requirement for induction at a separate commission meeting, and to accept the names for induction that were enrolled today. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #8 Take action on Items of Interest

a. Definition of minimum background investigation requiring hiring agency to meet or exceed a minimum background established by TCLEOSE and background investigation form to be maintain in officer's file

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to move forward with a rule and form for a minimum background investigation requirement. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

b. Review the process for on-line training / alternative delivery methods Staff was directed to move forward on this item. No motion was necessary.

c. Intermediate proficiency certificate, required courses Staff was directed to move forward on this item. No motion was necessary.

d. Removal of the SFST practitioner certification Staff was directed to move forward on this item. No motion was necessary.

e. Occupations Code Chapter 53 and jailer disqualification Staff was directed to move forward on this item and to return to the next meeting with proposed rules and legislative changes. No motion was necessary.

Agenda item #9 Take action on the application of Hill College to be a law enforcement academy

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the application of Hill College to be a law enforcement academy. Commissioner Oakley seconded the motion. The motion passed with Commissioner Hollingsworth abstaining.
