The Grande Voiture du Texas would like to invite you to the 2017 Central States Promenade to be held April 27-30, 2017 in Austin, Texas. Our event will be at the Crown Plaza Hotel, 6121 N. I-35, Austin, Texas 78752 (See attached hotel information form).

Registration fee is \$80 per person and will include the Friday evening BBQ at the hotel, Saturday evening banquet, 2017 Central States Promenade pin, Souvenir Program and the Hospitality Room hosted by the Grande Voiture du Texas. (Registration form attached)

Group Activities:

THURSDAY: Shopping or a choice of several local attractions is close by for those who come in early and wish to strike out on your own. The Bullock State History Museum, LBJ Library and Museum, Ladybird Johnson Wildflower Center and Zilker Botanical Gardens are all highly recommended. There are many other choices as well. Golf Tournament: Golfers will get a chance to play one of Austin's local courses Friday morning (sign up via the registration page). **Custom Austin Tour:** We have a 2 part trip for everyone to enjoy:

Part 1 will leave the hotel at 10 am with a charter bus taking our group to the Texas Military Forces Museum at Camp Mabry.

- The Texas Merci Boxcar is one of the showcase items in the Great Hall of the museum, but there are many other displays to be seen covering Texas military forces from 1823 to present. A light lunch will be provided free of charge.
- We will depart Camp Mabry at approximately 12 noon to view a selection of gifts from the Texas Merci Boxcar which are on display at the Capitol Visitor Center. Some of these items have not been on display since 1949.

Part 2 begins from the Texas Capitol at 2:00 pm with a relaxing and fun private group tour via Austin Duck Adventures.

- The 75 minute tour is highly rated and will show you highlights of Austin from a unique perspective. You may bring snacks and beverages with you on the tour and the tour will end back at the Crowne Plaza Hotel at about 4:00 pm.
- There is a maximum of 44 seats available on this tour.

Those who do not wish to go on Part 2 of the tour can take the charter back to the hotel at 2:00 pm. See the registration form for costs and to indicate your choice.

The Hospitality Room will open Thursday at 3:00 pm to midnight; Friday 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm and will open after the BBQ until midnight; Saturday after the Promenade 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm and will open after the banquet until midnight.

If you are flying into Austin you will need to obtain your own transportation to the hotel. Shuttle service is generally limited to within 3 miles of the hotel. If you need assistance – please ask.
