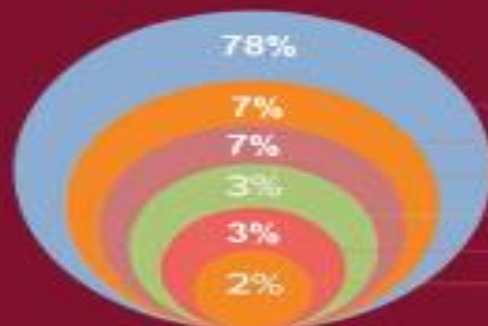

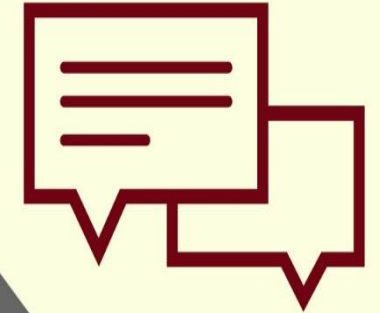


MOCK INTERVIEWS

- **Complete a final project on a career or student development related topic.**

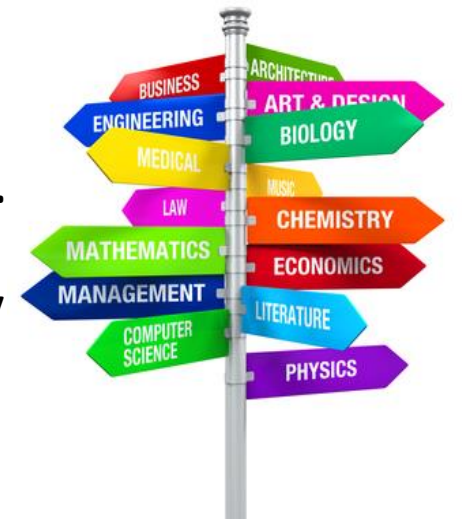

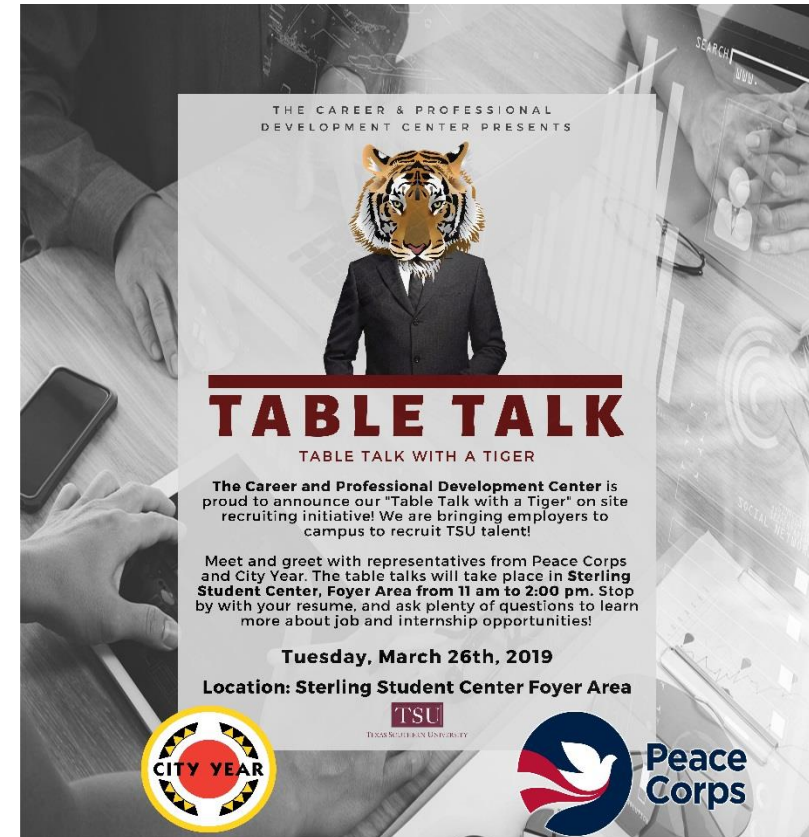

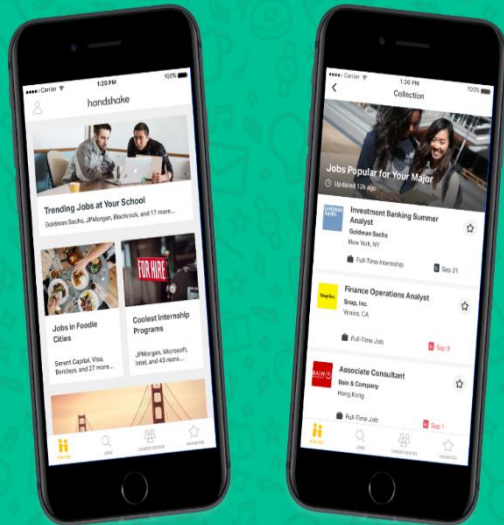
