

It is an American Metalcraft Stone - 14" x 15" Rectangular Ceramic Pizza Baking Stone (124STONE14) available from the <a href="http://www.webstaurantstore.com">http://www.webstaurantstore.com</a> for \$9.69. Keep in mind that these stones do get brittle after a few heating's so you'll want to travel with it on edge in one of your cupboards to keep it from breaking.. We did settle on the Christmas Party date and location at Saturday's meeting. This year we will return to the Glen Rose Community Center, 107 Sheppard Street, Glen Rose, Texas on Sunday, December 13th. Similar to last year, we will

do the pot luck and gift exchange. More info will be available as we get nearer the holiday season.
