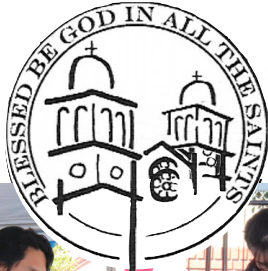

God's Greatest Commandments

Today's first reading recalls the most sacred text in Judaism, the Shema Israel: "Hear, [O] Israel." These words are so sacred for Jews, they are prayed in the most important moments of peril or supreme holiness. Jews don't take these words lightly because they express the essence of their religion and relationship to God.

As Catholics, we fully agree with our Jewish brothers and sisters on this matter. Jesus himself answered the question of what was the first, greatest commandment—it was the Shema Israel. Why is it so important? Because it declares the unity of God: "The LORD is our God, the LORD alone!" (Deuteronomy 6:4). He is one supreme God, not a multitude of divinities as in the Greek and Roman polytheistic religions, or even today in Hinduism and Buddhism.

This belief in one God makes the monotheistic religions of Judaism and Christianity unique. Second, this supreme God deserves our love and obedience. "You shall love the Lord your God..." Our role as creatures called and saved by him is to offer loving obedience.

The Second Commandment flows from the first: If we love God above all, then we need to love our brothers, sisters, and ourselves.

What better icon is there of this love for God and neighbor than the love of a mother for her child, as shown in this wax sculpture? As the piece shows, our love should be reverent, tender, compassionate, and unique. Only you can give him your kind of love. There should be a constant flow of affection and union between us—no separation between him and us.

La primera lectura de hoy recuerda el texto más sagrado del judaísmo, el Shema Israel: "Oye, [O] Israel". Estas palabras son tan sagradas para los judíos, que se rezan en los momentos más importantes de peligro o santidad suprema. Los judíos no toman estas palabras a la ligera porque expresan la esencia de su religión y su relación con Dios. Como católicos, estamos totalmente de acuerdo con nuestros hermanos y hermanas judíos en este asunto. El mismo Jesús respondió a la pregunta de cuál fue el primer y más grande mandamiento: fue el Shemá Israel, por que es tan importante? Porque declara la unidad de Dios: "¡El Señor es nuestro Dios, solo el Señor!" (Deuteronomio 6: 4). Es un Dios supremo, no una multitud de divinidades como en las religiones politeístas griega y romana, o incluso hoy en día en el hinduismo y el budismo. Esta creencia en un Dios hace que las religiones monoteístas del judaísmo y el cristianismo sean únicas. Segundo, este Dios supremo merece nuestro amor y obediencia. "Amarás al Señor tu Dios ..." Nuestro papel como criaturas llamadas y salvadas por él es ofrecer una obediencia amorosa. El Segundo Mandamiento fluye desde el primero: si amamos a Dios sobre todo, entonces debemos amar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas, y a nosotros mismos. ¿Qué mejor icono hay de este amor por Dios y el prójimo que el amor de una madre por su hijo, como se muestra en esta escultura de cera? Como muestra la pieza, nuestro amor debe ser reverente, tierno, compasivo y único. Solo tú puedes darle tu tipo de amor. Debe haber un flujo constante de afecto y unión entre nosotros, no hay separación entre él y nosotros.

Dear Padre,

Can you clarify the role of nuns and women in the Church? When I was growing up, they seemed much more involved, but nowadays our church never seems to discuss their role or support their work.

Women's role in the Church is essential in many areas, including teaching, passing on the faith to their families, and witnessing to their faith in the community. Religious sisters are essential to the Church's pastoral care, as Vatican II states: "From the outset of the work of evangelization, the missionary 'planting' and expansion of the Church require the presence of the religious life in all its forms" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 927).

Religious sisters, and their religious brothers, share a universal call to be "devoted to the welfare of the whole Church...working to implant and strengthen the Kingdom of Christ" in a new generation of Catholics (*Dogmatic Constitution on the Church [Lumen Gentium]*, 44).

Today, sisters have declined in number, but they are present and essential to Church ministry through religious education, pastoral care in hospitals, faith-based social outreach, and parish and diocesan administration. They continue Christ's presence, as did the women first to encounter the risen Christ and bring this Good News to others.

We need religious sisters; parents and parishes need to speak about vocations. God gives the gift, and we have the responsibility to nurture those women "called to signify the very charity of God in the language of our time" (*CCC* 926).
