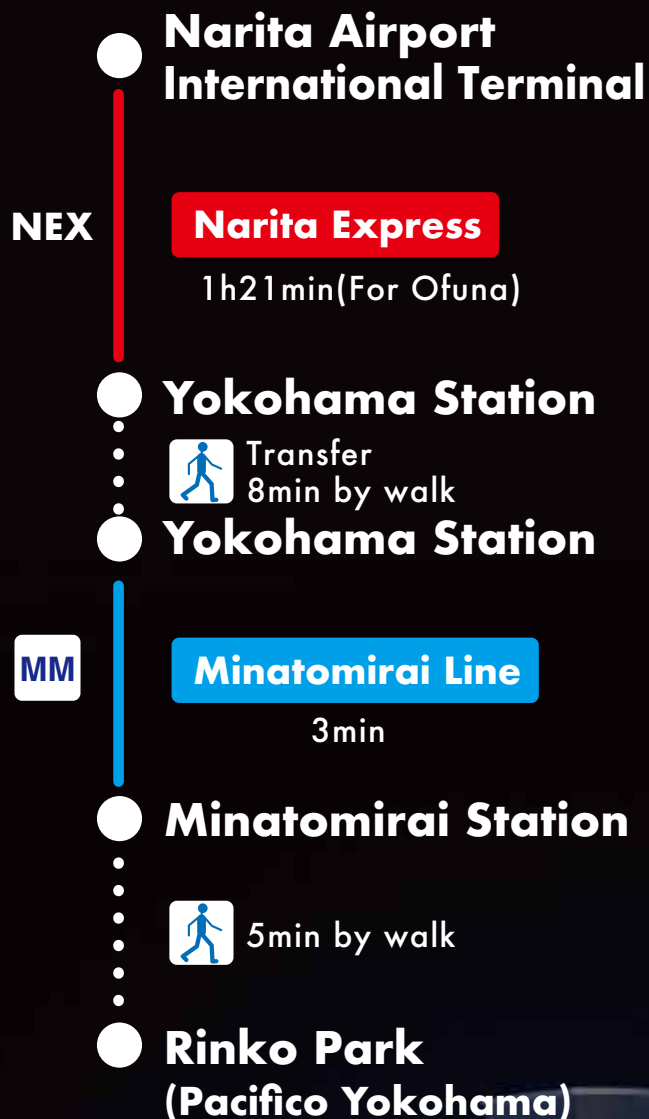

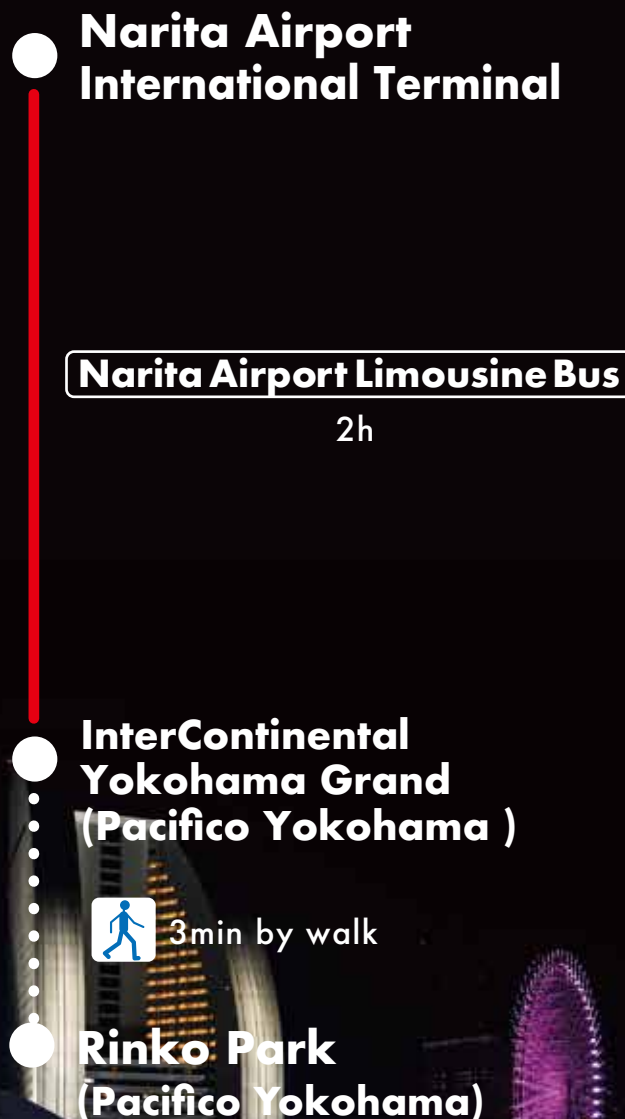

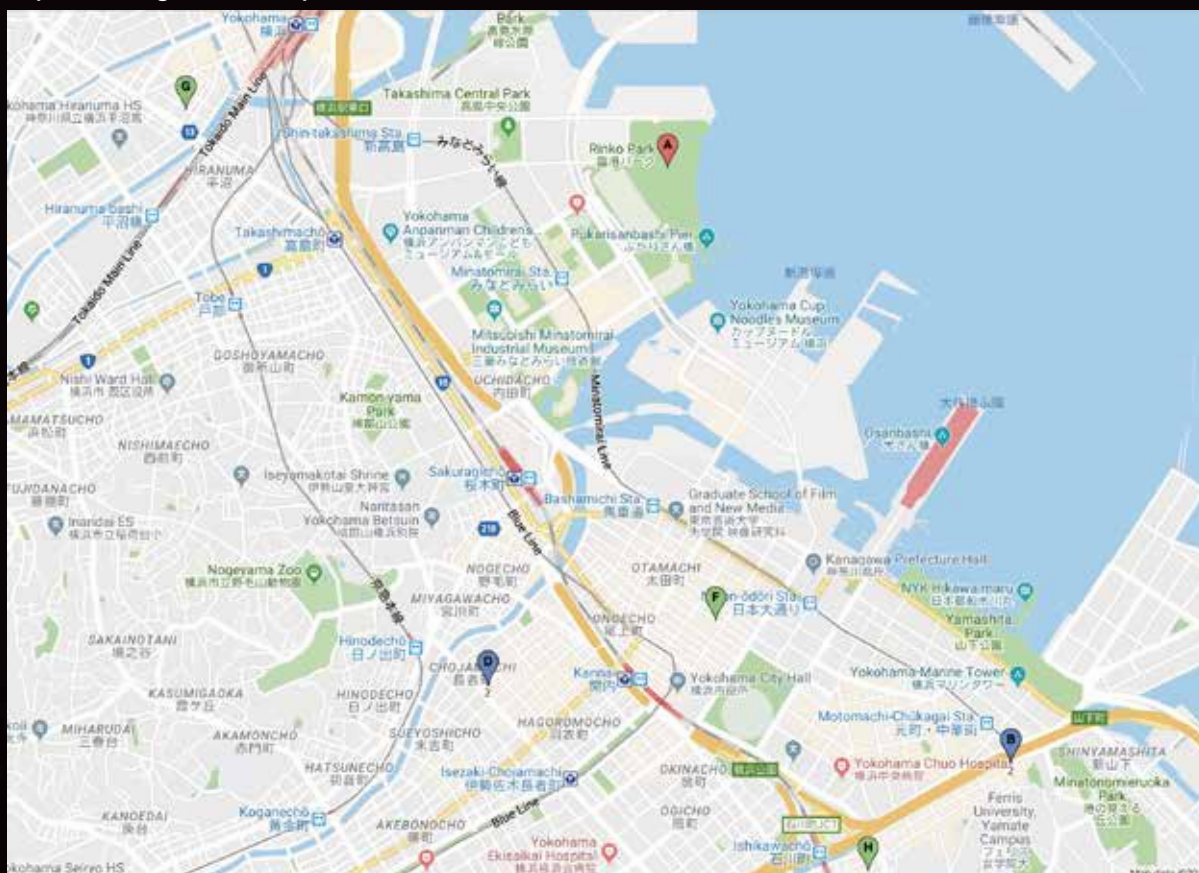

# JERSEY REQUIREMENTS



Every Jersey Design needs to be approved on site by the Red Bull Ice Cross World Championship Yokohama 2020 Sport Coordinator, **Oliver Deby**. A rider will not be allowed to skate on the track if his/her jersey has not been approved!

## Rules for riders jerseys' designs.

Area reserved for the official 2018/2019 Red Bull Crashed Ice tour patch. The reserved area needs to be 13 x12 cm. (The patch will be provided and glued on the first race of the season)



12 cm minimum distance between the official tour patch and the personal sponsor logo(s)

All athletes shall reserve free areas (minimum 16 cm high) on each sleeve of their individual  
-Total of 3 spots needs to be protected  
-Reserve a space for the ATSX patch and potential World Championship series partner



Area reserved for the federation patches. The ATSX-Federation patch is mandatory for riders competing in Red Bull Ice Cross World Championship races.

**A rider won' t be allowed to skate on the track if his/her jersey is not respecting the regulations**
