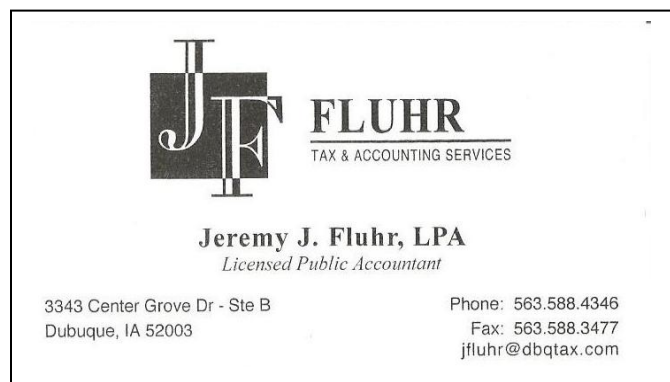
Deadline to apply is March 31st. Scholarships will be awarded in May at the annual awards/installation dinner.

\*Two recipients are selected from graduating seniors attending high school in Dubuque.

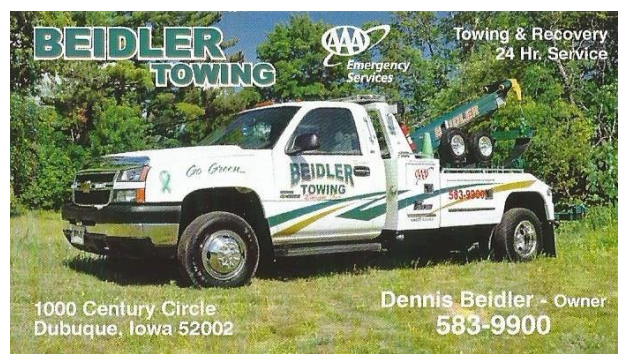
\*The Austin J. Hennings scholarship is selected from a graduating senior attending Hempstead High School.


## Banquet Coordinator




