Deadline to apply is March 31st. Scholarships will be awarded in May at the annual awards/installation dinner.


There are four available scholarships this year.


Banquet Coordinator


Please sign-up at the club if you are interested in helping with upcoming banquet functions. We need help bartending (must be club qualified to bartend)
